

## **Psalms 119:1-8 (NLT)**

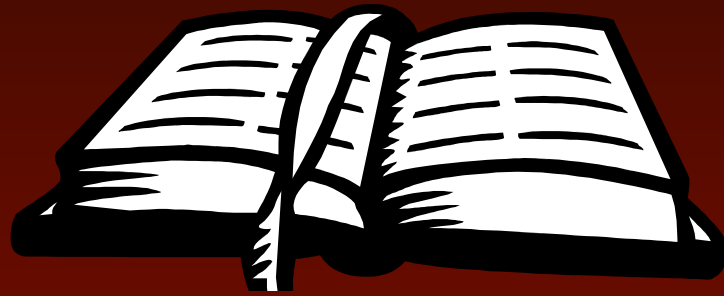
