**Psalm 23:3-4 (HCS)** [3] He renews my life; He leads me along the right paths for His name's sake. [4] Even when I go through the darkest valley, I fear no danger, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff - they comfort me.

**Psalm 23:5-6 (HCS)** [5] You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. [6] Only goodness and faithful love will pursue me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD as long as I live.

Psalm 23:1-6

The SHEPHERD will ASSUME full responsibility for the needs and safety of His flock, even RISKING His own life for THEIR PROTECTION. Psalm 23:1 (HCS) The LORD is my shepherd; there is NOTHING I LACK.

Psalm 23:1 (NLT) The LORD is my shepherd; have ALL that NEED.

#### **Psalm 34:8-10** (NLT)

Taste and see that the LORD is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in him! [9] Fear the LORD, you his godly people, for those who FEAR him will have all they NEED. [10] Even strong young lions sometimes go hungry, but those who TRUST in the LORD will lack NO good thing.

Philippians 4:12-13 (NLT) I know how to live on **ALMOST NOTHING** or WITH EVERYTHING. I have learned the secret of living in every situation, whether it is with a FULL stomach or **EMPTY**, with **PLENTY** or LITTLE. [13] For I can do everything THROUGH Christ, who gives me STRENGTH.
