Psalm 25:4-5 (NLT)

Show me the right path, O LORD; point out the road for me to follow. ⁵ Lead me by your truth and teach me, for you are the God who saves me. All day long I put my hope in you.

Psalm 25:6-7 (NLT)

Remember, O LORD, your compassion and unfailing love, which you have shown from long ages past. ⁷ Do not remember the rebellious sins of my youth. Remember me in the light of your unfailing love, for you are merciful, O LORD.

Proverbs 26:12 (NIV)

Do you see a man **WISE** in his own eyes?

There is more **HOPE** for a **FOOL**
than for him.

Proverbs 29:20 (NIV)

Do you see a man who **SPEAKS** in
HASTE?

There is more **HOPE** for a **FOOL**
than for him.

The right road is **not an EASY** one on
which to walk...

The essence of **the road of the righteous**
is this: it is a road **too difficult to walk**
without the companionship and friendship
of God.

→ There is **NO SHAME** in Following
Christ **Wholeheartedly**

² in You I **TRUST**, O my God.

Do **not** let me be **put to shame**,
nor let my enemies triumph over me.

Hebrews 12:2 (NIV)

Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him **endured the cross,** **scorning its SHAME,** and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Hebrews 12:3 (NIV)

Consider Him who **endured** such **opposition** from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

Acts 5:41 (NAS)

...**REJOICING** that they had been
considered worthy to suffer SHAME
for **His NAME.**

1 Corinthians 1:26-27 (NLT)

Remember, dear brothers and sisters, that **FEW of you were wise** in the world's eyes **OR powerful OR wealthy** when God called you. ²⁷ Instead, **God chose** things the world considers **foolish** in order **to SHAME** those who think they are wise. And **He chose** things that are **powerless to SHAME** those who are powerful.

FORGIVENESS is that act of **GRACE**
whereby **God extends His love**, as if the
sin or rebellion had never taken place.

Psalm 130:3-4 (NET)

If **You**, O LORD, **were to keep track of sins**, O Lord, **who could stand before You?** ⁴ But **YOU are willing to forgive**, so that You might be honored.

→ Do we Really WANT God to LEAD
and GUIDE us?

⁴ Show me Your ways, O LORD,
teach me Your paths; ⁵ guide me
in Your truth and teach me

We MUST...

- **SEEK** God's Direction
- **LEARN** from his WORD
- **OBEY** His Commands

→ In His **MERCY** and **LOVE** God
chooses **NOT** to **Remember** our sins

⁶ **REMEMBER**, O LORD, Your great
mercy and love...

⁷ Remember **NOT** the **sins** of my youth

Psalm 103:11-12 (NLT)

For **His UNFAILING LOVE** toward those who fear Him is as great as the **height** of the **heavens** above the earth.

¹² **He has REMOVED** our **sins** as far from us as the **east** is from the **west**.
