## Philippians 3:12 (HCS)

<sup>12</sup> Not that I have already reached [the goal] or am already fully mature, but I make every effort to take hold of it because I also have been taken hold of by Christ Jesus.

## Philippians 3:13-14 (HCS)

<sup>13</sup> Brothers, I do not consider myself to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and reaching forward to what is ahead, <sup>14</sup> I pursue as my goal the prize promised by God's heavenly call in Christ Jesus.

the PAST**

**Philippians 3:12-21**

Paul was a spiritual giant in the eyes of the Philippian believers, so he wanted them to know that **he had not yet attained the GOALS** stated in vs 10. He was still actively pressing on towards them.

Acts 8:3 (NIV)

But Saul **began to DESTROY the church**. Going from house to house, he **dragged off men and women** and put them in prison.

Acts 9:1-2 (NIV)

...Saul was **still breathing out murderous threats** against the Lord's disciples. He went to the high priest<sup>2</sup> and asked him for letters to the synagogues in Damascus...



1 Timothy 1:13-14 (NIV)

Even though **I was once a blasphemer**  
and a **persecutor** and a **violent man**,  
**I was shown MERCY** because I acted  
in ignorance and unbelief. <sup>14</sup> The  
**GRACE of our Lord** was poured out on  
**me abundantly**, along with the faith  
and love that are in Christ Jesus.

→ Do not let the **PAST**  
get in the way of **KNOWING**  
and  
**GROWING** in **Jesus**
