

Romans 8:31-32 (JBP)

³¹ In face of all this, what is there left to say? If God is for us, who can be against us? ³² He that did not hesitate to spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all - can we not trust such a God to give us, with Him, everything else that we need?

Romans 8:35-36 (JBP)

- ³⁵ Can anything separate us from the love of Christ? Can trouble, pain or persecution? Can lack of clothes and food, danger to life and limb, the threat of force of arms?**
- ³⁶ Indeed some of us know the truth of the ancient text: For your sake we are killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter'.**

Romans 8:37-38 (JBP)

³⁷ No, in all these things we win an overwhelming victory through Him who has proved His love for us. ³⁸ I have become absolutely convinced that neither death nor life, neither messenger of Heaven nor earthly ruler, neither what happens today nor what may happen tomorrow,

Romans 8:39 (JBP)

³⁹ neither a power from on high nor a power from below, nor anything else in God's whole world has any power to separate us from the love of God in Jesus Christ our Lord.

but not crushed; **perplexed**, but not in
despair; ⁹ **persecuted**, but not

but not destroyed.

Hebrews 11:35-38 (NLT)

³⁵ ...others were **tortured**... ³⁶ Some were **jeered** at, and their backs were **cut open** with whips. Others were **chained in prisons**. ³⁷ Some **died by stoning**, some were **sawed in half**, and others were **killed** with the sword. Some went about **wearing skins** of sheep and goats, **destitute** and **oppressed** and **mistreated**. ³⁸ They were too good for this world, **wandering** over deserts and mountains, **hiding** in caves and holes in the ground.

But **thanks be** to God.

He gives us the VICTORY

2 Corinthians 4:9 (NLT)

⁹ We are **hunted down**,
but NEVER abandoned by God.

We get **knocked down**,
but we are **NOT destroyed.**

→ We are Victorious and Conquering Sheep

³⁶ For Your sake we are killed every day;
we are being **slaughtered like sheep**. (NLT)

Luke 10:3 (NIV)

Go. I am sending you out like
lambs among wolves.

John 16:33 (NIV)

I have told you these things, so that
in **ME** you may have peace.

In this world you **WILL** have **TROUBLE...**

³³ ... But **take heart.**

I have **OVERCOME** the world.

³⁷ **NO**, despite **ALL** these things,
OVERWHELMING VICTORY is ours
through **Christ**, who **loved us**.

**→ We are Very PRECIOUS and
Deeply LOVED**

³⁷ NO, despite ALL these things,
overwhelming victory is ours through
Christ, who LOVED us. (NLT)

Romans 8:32 (NIV)

He who **did NOT spare** His own **Son**,
but **GAVE** Him up for us all -
how will He not also, along with Him,
graciously give us ALL things?

→ I am **CONVINCED - NOTHING** can
Separate me From God's **LOVE**

Romans 8:38 (NLT)

And I am **CONVINCED** that
nothing can ever **separate** us
from **God's love.**

2 Corinthians 4:8-9 (NLT)

We are **pressed on every side**
by troubles, but we are **NOT** crushed.

We are **perplexed**, but **NOT** driven
to **despair**.⁹ We are **hunted down**,
but **NEVER** abandoned by **God**.

We get **knocked down**,
but we are **NOT** destroyed.
