**Isaiah 26:8** (NET) Yes, as your judgments unfold, O Lord, we wait for you. We desire your fame and reputation to grow.

**Isaiah 26:8** (NASU) Indeed, while following the way of Your judgments, O LORD, <u>We have WAITED for You eagerly</u>; Your name, even Your memory, is the desire of our souls.

\*\*\*\*Isaiah has spoken of God's *judgments* as a punishment from God on the wicked and disobedient. However, *judgments* is also descriptive of God's Word and Way. That seems to make the most sense in this passage. Isaiah says he is EAGERLY waiting for God's plan and His promises to unfold. Along with that eager waiting his desire is for God's reputation and fame to grow. He wants God's reputation to be as great as HE actually is. I wonder how many times am I more interested in God's reputation then my own? How often am I eagerly waiting to see HOW God will unfold His plan in my life.

**PRAYER:** O God, help me to always be more interested in Your fame, and reputation rather than my own. Please help me Lord to Eagerly willingly wait for You to Unfold Your plan in my life.
