Isaiah 46:9-10 Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me. [10] I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say: My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.

***How big is Our God? Do we stop and remember what He has done in the past for his Church, and for us? Do we stop regularly and think about the Awesome Power, Majesty and Sovereignty of God and how this incredible God answers our prayers? "Prayer has the wonderful capacity to highlight our emptiness and God's fullness at the same time. It is wonderfully suited to express our inadequacy and God's all-sufficiency. When prayer looks away from our flaws and deficiencies to God for his future grace, he gets the glory he deserves and we get the good that we need." (Future Grace - Piper pg. 107)

Prayer: O God, thank You that Your Plan WILL triumph, and that You are in control of all things at all times. Thank You that nothing that is going on in my life has caught You by surprise. Please Lord God help me to Trust You for the Strength to follow and obey You through these difficulties in my life.
