Luke 6:35-36 But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because *HE is kind to the ungrateful and wicked*. [36] <u>Be merciful</u>, just <u>as your Father is merciful</u>. [NIV]

This whole passage is full of hard things. The last thing I want to do with someone who is acting like my enemy is do good to them. I would really rather do something much worse than that if I'm honest. Yet the Lord Jesus is very clear; I'm supposed to love my enemies, do good to them, even lend to them never expecting it to be returned. Why? Because that makes me become a child of God? NEVER. If I am able to do this, it is the grace of God working in me. Helping me to see that I am supposed to submit to my Lord Jesus no matter what. In submitting to Him I obey and He gives me the strength to do good even to those who are my enemies. That is one of the proofs that there is REALITY in my walk with Jesus Christ. When I do good to them can only be explained as the work of God in me. And loving my enemies and doing good to them can only happen by God's grace at work in my life. Of course, the patter for all of this is God Himself. What does God do? He is "kind to the ungrateful and wicked."
