Psalms 17:3-5 (NLT) ...I am DETERMINED <u>not to sin</u> <u>in what I say</u>. [4] I have <u>followed</u> <u>your</u> COMMANDS, which keep me from following cruel and evil people. [5] My steps have stayed on YOUR PATH; I have NOT wavered from FOLLOWING YOU.
