As Christians it is easy for us to take the sacrifice of Jesus and the purpose for which He saved us for granted as well. Let's look at Titus together today.

**Titus 2:11-14** (ESV) For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, [12] training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, [13] waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, [14] who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are ZEALOUS for good works.

"...we are saved for good works, not by good works. And the aim of Christ is not the mere ability to do them, but the PASSION to do them. ...Christ did not die to make good works merely possible or to produce a half-hearted pursuit. He died to produce in us a passion for good deeds. Christian purity is not the mere avoidance of evil but the pursuit of good. ...God is shown to be glorious by the good deeds of Christians. For that glory Christ suffered and died. ...It is the best life, no matter what it costs us in this world: They get help, we get joy, God gets glory." (Fifty Reasons Jesus Came to Die - Piper pg. 91)
