We BELIEVE the... Church is NOT a BUILDING

Acts 2:42-47

We believe that the true church includes ALL who have been **Justified** by God's Grace through Faith alone in Christ alone. They are united by the Holy Spirit in the body of Christ, of which He is the Head. The true church is seen clearly in local churches, whose membership is composed only of believers. EFCA

Matthew 16:18 (ESV)

And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock

I WILL build MY church,

and the gates of hell shall not prevail

against it.

Ephesians 1:22-23 (NLT)

God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has made Him head over ALL things for the BENEFIT of the CHURCH.

[23] And the church IS HIS body;

it is made full and complete by Christ, who fills all things everywhere with himself.

1 Corinthians 12:12-13 (NLT)

The human body has many parts, but the many parts make up one whole body.

So it is with **THE BODY of Christ**.

[13] Some of us are Jews, some are Gentiles, some are slaves, and some are free.

But we have ALL been BAPTIZED into ONE BODY by one Spirit, and we all share the same Spirit.

→ The Church BELONGS to Jesus Christ

→ The Church is made up of FORGIVEN sinners

1 Peter 2:9-10 (NIV)

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people BELONGING to God, THAT you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light. [10] Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

>Assumed POSITIVE Intent

>Remember we ALL have WOUNDS

[42] They **DEVOTED** themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

[43] Everyone was FILLED with AWE, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles.

[44] All the believers were together and had everything in common. [45] Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need.

Descriptive - of what they did for a short time

Prescriptive - not commanded or Required

[46] Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts,

[47] **praising God** and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the **Lord added** to their **number daily** those who were being saved.

The VERY First Church met for...

- Teaching
- Fellowship
- Breaking of Bread
- Prayer
- Praise and Worship God

They had a definite doctrinal standard, the apostle's teaching; they had **fellowship** with one another as believers; they observed the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper; they met for public worship; and they contributed to the support of the needy.

→ They DEVOTED themselves to Christ and His Church

The were bighearted and GENEROUS towards others

>To be Generous is to be OPENHANDED not

1 Corinthians 3:10-11 (NIV)
For we are God's fellow workers; you are
God's field, God's building.
[10] By the grace God has given me,
I laid a FOUNDATION as an expert builder,

and someone else is building on it. But each one should be careful how he builds.

[11] For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.

In PLANTING local churches

Jesus Christ must be the FOUNDATION,
