1 Corinthians 11:23-24 (NLT) For I pass on to you what I received from the Lord himself. On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took some bread [24] and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me."

1 Corinthians 11:25-26 (NLT) In the same way, he took the cup of wine after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people - an agreement confirmed with my blood. Do this to remember me as often as you drink it." [26] For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are announcing the Lord's death until he comes again.

Matthew 28:18-20 (NLT)

Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. [19] Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. [20] Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

We BELIEVE in the...

ORDINANCES of the Church

Matt. 28:18-20 and 1 Cor. 11:23-30

Acts 2:41 (NLT)

Those who BELIEVED what Peter said were baptized and added to the church that day - about 3,000 in all.

Acts 8:36 (NLT)

As they rode along, they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "Look! There's some water! Why can't I be BAPTIZED?"
...[38] He ordered the carriage to stop, and they went down into the WATER, and Philip BAPTIZED him.

Acts 16:31-33 (NLT)

They replied, "BELIEVE in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with everyone in your household." [32] And they shared the WORD of the Lord with him and with ALL who lived in his household. [33] Even at that hour of the night, the jailer cared for them and washed their wounds. Then he and everyone in his household were IMMEDIATELY baptized.

Romans 6:4-5 (NLT)

For we **DIED** and were **BURIED**

with Christ by BAPTISM. And just as

Christ was RAISED from the DEAD by the glorious power of the Father,

now we also may live new lives.

[5] Since we have been UNITED with Him in His death, we will also be raised to life as He was.

Baptism illustrates a **believer's IDENTIFICATION** with

Christ's death, burial, and resurrection.

Everywhere the gospel is preached and people are drawn to faith IN Christ, they are to be **BAPTIZED**.

→ Baptism does not SAVE US

Matt. 8.19 ...go and make disciples of ALL nations, **BAPTIZING** them...

Acts 2.41 ...Those who **BELIEVED** what Peter said were **BAPTIZED**...

→ You do NOT have to get your Life in order to be Baptized

There is NO OFFICIAL age set for Baptism

→ Danger in putting it ASIDE

Ephesians 5:8 (NLT)

For once you were full of darkness, but **now** you have light from the Lord.

So live as people of light!

The Bible does **not** give us specific instruction as to **FREQUENCY**, so there is **some latitude** in **how often** a church should **observe the Lord's Supper**. It should be **often enough to RENEW FOCUS on Christ**, without being so often that it becomes routine. gotquestion.org

In any case, it's not the frequency that matters but the **HEART** attitude of those who participate. We should partake with reverence, love, and a deep sense of gratitude for the Lord Jesus, who was willing to die on the cross to take upon Himself our sins. aotauestion.ora

→ We were NOT told HOW to CELEBRATE the Lord's Supper

The Bread and Wine do NOT become the BODY and BLOOD of Christ

→ We do NOT receive any SPECIAL Grace when we celebrate the Lord's Supper

1 Peter 2:24 (NLT) He personally carried our sins **in His <u>BODY</u>** on the cross so that we can be dead to sin

Ephesians 1:7 (NLT) He is so rich in kindness and grace that He purchased our freedom with the BLOOD of His Son and FORGAVE our sins.

The body of our Savior Jesus Christ
Torn for you - eat and remember
The wounds that heal the death that brings us life
Paid the price to make us one

The blood that cleanses
every stain of sin
Shed for you drink and remember
