Hebrews 10:32-33 (NLT) Think back on those early days when you first learned about Christ. Remember how you remained faithful even though it meant terrible suffering. [33] Sometimes you were exposed to public ridicule and were beaten, and sometimes you helped others who were suffering the same things.

Hebrews 10:34 (NLT) You suffered along with those who were thrown into jail, and when all you owned was taken from you, you accepted it with joy. You knew there were better things waiting for you that will last forever.

Hebrews 10:35-36 (NLT) So do not throw away this confident trust in the Lord. Remember the great reward it brings you! [36] Patient endurance is what you need now, so that you will continue to do God's will. Then you will receive all that He has promised.

# **Consider JESUS** Hebrews 12:3-4

### Message of HEBREWS...

- Jesus is **SUPERIOR**
- do not GO BACK
- you Must PERSEVERE

### Hebrews 12:1 (NIV)

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us **throw off everything that hinders** and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Hebrews 12.2 (NIV) Let us FIX our EYES on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

#### Hebrews 10:32-34 (NIV)

Remember those earlier days after you had received the light, when you stood your ground in a great contest in the face of suffering. [33] Sometimes you were **publicly exposed to insult** and persecution; at other times you stood side by side with those who were so treated. [34] You sympathized with those in prison and joyfully accepted the confiscation of your property, because you knew that you yourselves had better and lasting possessions.

#### Hebrews 10:35-36 (NIV)

So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. [36] You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what He has promised. Two sins are in view here: the daily sins, things in life that TRIP us, ENTANGLE us, and bring us down; and the CROWNING sin of throwing in the towel, of giving up the race altogether. John 15:20 (NIV) Remember the words I spoke to you: No servant is GREATER than his MASTER. If they persecuted ME, they will persecute you also... Salvation by Grace is FREE we cannot earn it - we don't deserve it it is God's Free Gift to us

Discipleship is COSTLY we are called to DAILY Obedience to Daily SURRENDER John 6:67 (NIV) ...Lord, to whom would we go? You have the WORDS that give eternal life. So why should we follow Jesus? >He is the ONLY ANSWER that makes any sense in a world gone totally crazy.

>He is the ONLY one who brings PEACE out of the chaos and the turmoil in our Lives.

>He is the ONLY one who can help us FACE the HARD THINGS we will ALL face. John 15:20 (NIV) ...No servant is greater than his MASTER. If they persecuted ME, they WILL persecute you also...

## John 16:33 (NIV) I have told you these things, **so that**

you may have peace. In this world you WILL HAVE trouble. But take heart! I have OVERCOME the world. This passage teaches us that we must be totally **ABSORBED** with Jesus. This requires turning AWAY from those things that distract us and then turning TOWARDS and consciously focusing and meditating on Jesus.

[3] CONSIDER HIM who endured such opposition from sinful men, SO THAT you will not grow WEARY and lose heart. This is the challenge to take our suffering - our hardship and TURN it INTO a Worship Experience

2 Corinthians 4:16-18 (NLT) That is why we NEVER give up. Though our bodies are dying, our spirits are being renewed every day. [17] For our present troubles areSMALL and won't last very long.Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever!

[18] So we don't LOOK at the TROUBLES we can see now; rather, we FIX our GAZE on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.

Don't let Fatigue, Pain, or Criticism force you to look AWAY from Jesus. Renew your commitment to serving Christ. **Don't forsake** your eternal reward because of the **intensity** of **today's pain**. Your very weakness allows the resurrection power of Christ to strengthen you moment by moment. LABC
