James 2:1 (NLT)

My dear brothers and sisters, how can you claim to have faith in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ if you favor some people over others?

James 2:8-9 (NLT)

Yes indeed, it is good when you obey the royal law as found in the Scriptures: "Love your neighbor as yourself." [9] But if you favor some people over others, you are committing a sin. You are guilty of breaking the law.

James 2:12-13 (NLT)

So whatever you say or whatever you do, remember that you will be judged by the law that sets you free. [13] There will be no mercy for those who have not shown mercy to others. But if you have been merciful, God will be merciful when he judges you.

The LAW that Gives FREEDOM

James 2:8-13

It only takes one broken law to make a lawbreaker.

PTW

The LAW is the expression of the Character and Will of God; therefore to violate one part of the Law

is to violate God's Will

and thus His whole Law... NIVSB

→ How we BREAK God's Law does not matter it makes us Law BREAKERS

James 2:10 (NLT)

For the person who keeps ALL of the laws except ONE is as guilty as a person who has broken ALL of God's laws.





→ Even if we BELONG to Christ it is STILL impossible to LIVE out the Law PERFECTLY

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NLT)

God saved you by **HIS GRACE** when you **BELIEVED**.

And you can't take credit for this;

it is a GIFT from God.

Salvation is NOT a reward for the good things WE have done,

so none of us can BOAST about it.

John 15:12 (NIV)
My command is this:
Love each other
AS I have loved you.

Romans 13:8 (NIV)

Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing DEBT to LOVE one another,

for he who loves his fellowman has FULFILLED the law.

John 15:1, 4-5 (NIV)

I AM the true vine, and my Father is the gardener.

...[4] Remain IN ME, and I will remain IN you.

No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain IN the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in ME.

[5] I am the vine; you are the branches.

If a man REMAINS in ME and I in him, he will bear much fruit;

APART from ME you can DO nothing.

For the Holy Spirit to Produce FRUIT we Must...

- Say NO to ourselves
- SURRENDER daily to God
- Keep ON Submitting to God's WORD

Ma---tthew 5:7 (NIV)
Blessed are the Merciful,
for they will be shown MERCY

→ The LAW gives FREEDOM by Showing us that we NEED a SAVIOR

Romans 8:3-4 (NIV)

For what the LAW was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature,

God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful man to BE a sin OFFERING.

And so He condemned sin in sinful man, in order that the righteous requirements of the LAW might be fully met in us...

→ Mercy Triumphs OVER Judgement

By showing MERCY to others a person gives genuine Evidence of having Received God's MERCY themselves.

MacArthur

[13] because judgment without mercy will be shown to anyone who has NOT been merciful...

2 Corinthians 5:10 (NIV)

For we must **ALL** appear

before the **judgment seat** of **Christ**,

that each one **may receive** what is **due** him

for the things done while in the body,

whether good or bad.

Romans 8:1 (NIV)

There is

NO CONDEMNATION

for those

who are IN Christ Jesus...

God's GRACE does not cancel my DUTY to OBEY Him; it gives my obedience a new foundation.

Mark 12:30-31 (NIV)
... Love the Lord your God with all your HEART and with all your SOUL and with all your MIND and with all your STRENGTH.'

The second is this:

Love your neighbor AS yourself.

There is no commandment greater than these.
