James 4:5-6 (NLT)

What do you think the Scriptures mean when they say that the spirit God has placed within us is filled with envy?

[6] But He gives us even more grace to stand against such evil desires. As the Scriptures say, God opposes the proud but favors the humble.

Hebrews 4:14-15 (NLT)

So then, since we have a great High Priest who has entered heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to what we believe.

[15] This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for He faced all of the same testings we do, yet He did not sin.

Hebrews 4:16 (NLT)

So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive His mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.

DESPERATELY in NEED of GRACE

James 4:4-6



MORE to COME

James identified the **source** of the bitter fighting as being the **Pursuit of Pleasure**. So now he moves to a **REBUKE** of his readers for **spiritual unfaithfulness**.

WORLD- the organized Satanic system that is opposed to God and hostile to Jesus and His followers...

Matthew 6:24 (NIV)

No one can serve **two masters**. Either he will **HATE** the one and **LOVE** the other, or he will be **DEVOTED** to the one and **DESPISE** the other.

You cannot serve both God and Money.

5- Or do you think Scripture says without reason that the Spirit

He has caused to

live IN us [by regeneration]

yearns jealously

[for our faithfulness to God].

They were being unfaithful to God and committing spiritual adultery with the world as they sought to satisfy their own cravings at the expense of church harmony.

→ Spiritual Adultery occurs
when we look OUTSIDE our relationship
with God to have our needs met.
It happens when we INVITE a third party,
the WORLD, into the relationship.

→ God is a JEALOUS God - He does not want to SHARE us with the world

Ephesians 4:30 (NLT)

And do not bring sorrow to God's Holy Spirit by the WAY you live.

Remember, He has identified you as His own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption.

The call is to **shun pride** and to **submit humbly** to **God's authority**.

The cure for conflict is a humble spirit which is rewarded by God's unmerited favor.

There is a Difference between Grace that SAVES us and Grace that SUSTAINS us

GRACE is **God's** HELP that we don't **DESERVE**.

God's Grace is GREATER than our **need** and **MORE** than we **ask**.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV)

For it is by GRACE you have been SAVED, through faith and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast.

Romans 5:1-2 (NIV)

Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

through whom we have

gained access by faith

into this GRACE in which we now stand.

And we **rejoice** in the **hope** of the **glory** of **God**.

As God gives us MORE GRACE, we realize that this world's **seductive** attractions are only cheap substitutes for what God has to offer. It is our choice - we can HUMBLE ourselves and receive God's GRACE, **OR** we can **continue** in our **pride** and self-sufficiency and experience His anger.

→ God OPPOSES the Proud...

Prov. 16:5 (NIV)

The LORD Detests all the proud of heart.

Be sure of this: They will not go unpunished.

Prov. 16:18 (HCS)

PRIDE comes before destruction, and an arrogant spirit before a fall.

Daniel 4:37 (NIV)

Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and exalt and glorify the King of heaven, because everything HE does is right

and all HIS ways are just.

And those who WALK in PRIDE

HE is able to humble.

→ God gives us GRACE so that we can LIVE His way

There will always be

ENOUGH grace

regardless of our situation or need.

Isaiah 66:2 (NIV)

...This is the one I esteem:

he who is **HUMBLE** and **contrite** in spirit,

and TREMBLES at MY WORD.

God has set a high standard for wholehearted love and devotion on the part of his people, but

He gives grace that is GREATER

than the rigorous demand HE has made.

Psalm 23:1-4 (NIV)

The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want.

- [2] He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters,
- [3] He **restores my soul**. **He guides** me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake.
- [4] Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for YOU are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

Hebrews 4:14 (NIV)

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess.

Hebrews 4:15 (NIV)

For we **do not** have a **High Priest** who is unable to **sympathize** with our weaknesses, but **we have one** who has been **tempted in every way**, just as we are - yet was without sin.

Hebrews 4:16 (NIV)

Let us then approach the

throne of grace with confidence,

so that

we may receive mercy

and find GRACE to help us

in our time of need.

He giveth MORE GRACE

when the burdens grow greater,
He sendeth **MORE** strength
when the labors increase;
To added afflictions He addeth His mercy,
To multiplied trials, His multiplied peace.

When we have exhausted our store of endurance, When our strength has failed ere the day is half done, When we reach the end of our hoarded resources -Our Father's full giving is only begun.

His love has no limits, His GRACE has no MEASURE, **His power** has no boundary known unto men; For out of His infinite riches in Jesus He giveth, and giveth, and giveth again.
