Matthew 6:19-21 (NLT)

Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. 20 Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹ Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.

Matthew 6:24 (NLT)

No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.

James 5:1-2 (NLT)

Look here, you rich people: Weep and groan with anguish because of all the terrible troubles ahead of you. ² Your wealth is rotting away, and your fine clothes are moth-eaten rags.

James 4:2-3 (ESV)

[2] ...You do not have, because you do not ask. [3] You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions.

James 5:3 (NLT)

Your gold and silver have become worthless. The very wealth you were counting on will eat away your flesh like fire. This treasure you have accumulated will stand as evidence against you on the day of judgment.

James 5:1-6

James 1:1 (ESV)

James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, **To the twelve tribes** in the Dispersion: Greetings.

→ James is writing ABOUT wicked wealthy unbelievers not TO them

James may have been using the corrosion of gold and silver as a symbol of the corrosive effects of greed on the human soul.

They have killed them by

OVERWORKING and UNDERPAYING
them. The innocent had no way to FIGHT

Back. To protest might result in further
brutality, or the loss of their job.

→ There is a PROPHETIC sense

to these verses –

Judgment is Coming

Rich non-Christian landowners who were oppressing poor believers would not hear the letter read. But Christian readers would learn from the judgment proclaimed on the rich

not to set too high a value on wealth.

James Declared Judgment on the WEALTHY as...

- ➤ an ENCOURAGEMENT to Christians who were Suffering
- > a WARNING not to ENVY the Wealthy
- ➤ a REMINDER God will AVENGE the Injustice

Romans 12:19 (NIV)

Do **NOT** take **REVENGE**, my friends,

but leave room for God's WRATH,

for it is written:

It is mine to AVENGE;

will repay, says the Lord.

→ There is a Difference between **SAVING** and **HOARDING**

Luke 12:13-15 (NET)

...Watch out and **guard** yourself from

ALL types of GREED,

because one's life does not consist in the **ABUNDANCE** of his **possessions**.

Antidote to HOARDING

LAB

- **➢ live SURRENDERED** to God
- be Fully aware of God's GRACE
- be sensitive to the **NEEDS** of others
- > keep ETERNITY firmly in view

Matthew 6:33 (NIV)

But seek FIRST His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Declaration Against the Wicked who Pursue Wealth...

- >at ALL COSTS
- > DISHONESTLY
- ➤ no matter who they HURT
- >IGNORING God completely

Luke 12:20-21 (NLT)

But God said to him, 'You fool! You will die this very night. Then who will get everything you worked for?'

²¹ "Yes, a person is a fool to store up earthly wealth but NOT have a rich RELATIONSHIP with God.

He is calling the unrighteous rich to mourn because of what awaits them in the final judgment. Their materialistic focus places them in terrifying peril.

Matthew 6:19-21 (NIV)

Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where **moth and rust destroy**, and where **thieves break in and steal**. ²⁰ But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.

²¹ For where your TREASURE is, there your Heart WILL BE also.

→ You CANNOT

take it WITH You

Command those who are rich in this present world NOT TO BE arrogant NOR to put their HOPE in WEALTH, which is so uncertain, but to put their HOPE in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment.

1 Timothy 6:18-19 (NIV)

Command them to do good, to

BE RICH in good deeds, and to

BE GENEROUS and willing to share.

In this way they will lay up TREASURE for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age...

Psalm 115:1-3 (NIV)

- ¹ Not to us, O LORD, not to us but to your name be the glory, because of your love and faithfulness. ² Why do the nations say, "Where is their God?"
- Our God is in heaven; **HE does** whatever pleases **HIM**.

Psalm 115:4-7 (NIV)

⁴ But their idols are silver and gold, made by the hands of men. ⁵ They have **mouths**, but cannot speak, **eyes**, but they **cannot see**; ⁶ they have **ears**, but **cannot hear**, **noses**, but they **cannot smell**; ⁷ they have **hands**, but **cannot feel**, **feet**, but they **cannot walk**; nor can they utter a sound with their throats.

Psalm 115:8 (NIV)

Those who MAKE them will be LIKE them, and so will ALL who TRUST in them.

→ We become LIKE that which we WORSHIP — We become LIKE that over which we OBSESS

We either **REVERE** the world and are **CONFORMED** to the sinful patterns of the world, or we **REVERE GOD** and are progressively **CONFORMED** into His likeness.

Matthew 6:24 (NIV)
