GOD - OUR ONLY SECURITY ~ **Psalm 46:1-11**

→ Scripture Reading Psalm 46:1-3 & 46:8-11

WE WILL NOT FEAR - OUR GOD IS NEAR ~ Psalm 46:1-3

[1] God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. [2] Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, [3] though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging. Selah

APPLICATION

Psalm 46:1 (HCS) God IS our REFUGE and STRENGTH, a HELPER who is always found in times of trouble.

- → God will SEEM so far away when we focus on our FEAR Rather than on God
- **2 Kings 19:14** (NIV) Hezekiah received the letter from the messengers and read it. Then he went up to the temple of the LORD and **spread it out before the LORD**.

GOD ALMIGHTY IS WITH US ~ Psalm 46:4-7

[4] There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy place where the Most High dwells. [5] God is within her, she will not fall; God will help her at break of day. [6] Nations are in uproar, kingdoms fall; he lifts his voice, the earth melts. [7] The LORD Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. *Selah*

Psalm 46:7 (NLT) The LORD of Heaven's Armies is here among us; the God of Israel IS OUR FORTRESS.

APPLICATION

2 Kings 19:15-19 (NLT) And Hezekiah prayed this prayer before the LORD: "O LORD, God of Israel, you are enthroned between the mighty cherubim! You alone are God of all the kingdoms of the earth. You alone created the heavens and the earth. [16] Bend down, O LORD, and listen! Open your eyes, O LORD, and see! Listen to Sennacherib's words of defiance against the living God. [17] It is true, LORD, that the kings of Assyria have destroyed all these nations. [18] And they have thrown the gods of these nations into the fire and burned them. But of course the Assyrians could destroy them! They were not gods at all - only idols of wood and stone shaped by human hands. [19] Now, O LORD our God, rescue us from his power; THEN all the kingdoms of the earth will know that you alone, O LORD, are God.

HEZEKIAH'S PRAYER - O LORD GOD...

- You are SOVEREIGN over ALL vs. 15
- You are the CREATOR of ALL vs. 15
- ➤ LISTEN to his Defiance against You vs. 16
- > RESCUE us from his power vs. 19
- SHOW the Nations YOU ALONE are God vs. 19

COME, SEE WHAT GOD HAS DONE ~ Psalm 46:8-11

[8] Come and see the works of the LORD, the desolations he has brought on the earth. [9] He makes wars cease to the ends of the earth; he breaks the bow and shatters the spear, he burns the shields with fire. [10] "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." [11] The LORD Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. *Selah*

2 Kings 19:34-35 (NIV) I will defend this city and save it, for my sake and for the sake of David my servant." [35] That night the angel of the LORD went out and put to death a hundred and eighty-five thousand men in the Assyrian camp. When the people got up the next morning - there were all the dead bodies!

Psalm 46:10 (NET) Stop your striving and RECOGNIZE that I am God! I will be exalted over the nations! I will be exalted over the earth!

APPLICATION

BE STILL, take your hands off, quit struggling. God Knows what He is doing, His Timing is Perfect, Trust Him. Wiersbe

PSALM 46:10

- Be STILL Stop TRYING to make life work without God
- KNOW I AM God Lay it ALL OUT before God
- I will be EXALTED Seek to EXALT God
