

Psalm 46:1-3 (NET)

God is our strong refuge; he is truly our helper in times of trouble. [2] For this reason we do not fear when the earth shakes, and the mountains tumble into the depths of the sea, [3] when its waves crash and foam, and the mountains shake before the surging sea.

Psalm 46:8-9 (NET)

[8] Come! Witness the exploits of the LORD, who brings devastation to the earth! [9] He brings an end to wars throughout the earth; he shatters the bow and breaks the spear; he burns the shields with fire.

Psalm 46:10-11 (NET)

[10] He says, “Stop your striving and recognize that I am God! I will be exalted over the nations! I will be exalted over the earth!” [11] The LORD who commands armies is on our side! The God of Jacob is our protector!

Psalm 46:1 (HCS)

God **IS** our **REFUGE** and
STRENGTH, a **HELPER**
who is **ALWAYS FOUND**
in times of trouble.

→ God will **SEEM** far away
when we focus on our **FEAR**
rather than on God

2 Kings 19:14 (NIV)

Hezekiah received the letter from the messengers and read it. Then he went up to the temple of the LORD and **SPREAD IT OUT before the LORD.**

Psalm 46:7 (NLT)

The LORD of **Heaven's Armies**

is **HERE** among us;

the God of Israel

is **OUR FORTRESS.**

2 Kings 19:15-16 (NLT)

And Hezekiah prayed this prayer before the LORD:
“O LORD, God of Israel, you are enthroned between
the mighty cherubim! **You ALONE are God of
all the kingdoms of the earth. You ALONE**
created the heavens and the earth. [16]
Bend down, O LORD, and listen! Open your
eyes, O LORD, and see! **Listen to**
Sennacherib’s words of DEFIANCE
against the living God.

2 Kings 19:17-18 (NLT)

It is true, LORD, that the kings of Assyria have destroyed all these nations. [18] And they have thrown the gods of these nations into the fire and burned them. **But of course the Assyrians**

could destroy them!

They were not gods at all

- only idols of wood and stone shaped by human hands.

2 Kings 19:19 (NLT)

Now, O LORD our God,

RESCUE us from his power;

THEN all the kingdoms of the earth

will KNOW

that **YOU ALONE, O LORD,** are God.

Hezekiah's Prayer - O LORD God...

- You are **SOVEREIGN** over **ALL**
- You are the **CREATOR** of **ALL**
- **LISTEN** to his **Defiance** against You
- **RESCUE** us from his power
- **SHOW** the Nations **YOU ALONE** are God

2 Kings 19:34-35 (NIV)

I will defend this city and save it, for my sake and for the sake of David my servant." [35]

That night the angel of the LORD went out and put to death a hundred and eighty-five thousand men in the Assyrian camp.

When the people got up the next morning -
there were all the dead bodies!

Psalm 46:10 (NET)

Stop your STRIVING

and RECOGNIZE that I am God!

I will be EXALTED over the nations!

I will be EXALTED over the earth!

BE STILL, take your hands off, quit struggling. God Knows what He is doing, His Timing is Perfect, Trust Him.

- **KNOW I AM God** - Lay it **ALL OUT** before God
- **I will be EXALTED** - Seek to **EXALT** God
