Psalm 63:3-5 (NLT)

[3] Your unfailing love is better than life itself; how I praise you! [4] I will praise you as long as I live, lifting up my hands to you in prayer. [5] You satisfy me more than the richest feast. I will praise you with songs of joy.

Psalm 63:6-8 (NLT)

[6] I lie awake thinking of you, meditating on you through the night. [7] Because you are my helper, I sing for joy in the shadow of your wings. [8] I cling to you; your strong right hand holds me securely.

Psalm 63:9-11 (NLT)

[9] But those plotting to destroy me will come to ruin. They will go down into the depths of the earth. [10] They will die by the sword and become the food of jackals. [11] But the king will rejoice in God. All who trust in him will praise him, while liars will be silenced.

- **CLING** to God

Meditation - the act of thinking about something carefully, calmly, seriously for an **extended period of time**.

Meditation is to **FOCUS** minds and thoughts on something over and over **seeking God's insight** and understanding.

Psalm 23:19 (NIV)

The Lord **IS MY Shepherd...**

Psalm 1:2-3 (NIV)

But his **DELIGHT** is **in the Law of the Lord**, and on his law he **MEDITATES day and night**. He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season, and whose leaf does not wither...

In Meditation ALWAYS Ask...

- What does it **SAY?**
- What does it **MEAN?**
- How should I **RESPOND?**

2 Corinthians 1:9-10 (NLT)

In fact, **we EXPECTED to DIE.** But as a result, we **STOPPED relying on OURSELVES** and **LEARNED to RELY ONLY on God,** who raises the dead. [10]

And he did rescue us from mortal danger, and he will rescue us again. We have placed our confidence in him, and he will continue to rescue us
