#### James 5:10-11 (NLT)



## A Call to PATIENT Perseverance

James 5:10-12

When we are tempted to believe that patience is impossible,

God REMINDS us of those who did endure with patience the trials HE allowed into their lives. LAB

# PERSEVERANCE is patience STRETCHED out Patience that is TESTED is PERSEVERANCE. LAB

Matthew 5:10 (NIV)

Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

### → Job's Perseverance was NOT based on his UNDERSTANDING of what God was doing LAB

## God's purpose is not that we develop a mind full of EXPLANATIONS and answers;

His PURPOSE is to bring us

to a place where we TRUST Him. LAB

He gives us more grace as our burdens grow greater, He sends us more strength as our labors increase: To added afflictions He adds all His mercy, To multiplied trials His Multiplied peace.

When we have exhausted our store of endurance, When our strength has failed and the day is half done, When we reach the end of our hoarded resources, Our Father's full giving is only **begun**.

### → God's PLANS and TIMING are what Matters

Job 5:17-18 (NIV)

Blessed is the man whom God corrects; so do not despise the discipline of the Almighty. <sup>18</sup> For HE wounds, but HE also binds up; HE injures, but HIS hands also heal.

Job 13:15 (NIV)

Though HE slay me, yet will I hope in HIM; I will surely defend my ways to HIS face.

Job 19:25 (NLT)

But as for me, I KNOW that my
Redeemer lives, and He will stand
upon the earth at last.


God does demand that we recognize

PERSECUTE you and falsely SAY all kinds of
EVIL against you because of ME. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice
and be glad, because great is your reward
in heaven, for in the same way they
persecuted the prophets who were
before you.

## → Say what you mean and mean what you say

### → What we SAY matters – WORDS mean Things

Colossians 3:9-10 (NIV)

Do not LIE to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices <sup>10</sup> and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

Colossians 3:15 (NIV)

#### Let the PEACE of Christ rule

in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace.

And be thankful.

Let the WORD of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts

And whatever you do, whether in WORD or DEED, do it all in the NAME of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

### → Job's Patient ENDURANCE was not PASSIVE

Job 12:2-3 (NLT)

You people really know everything, don't you? And when you die, wisdom will die with you! <sup>3</sup> Well, I know a few things myself - and you're no better than I am. Who doesn't know these things you've been saying?

Job 13:3-4 (NLT)

As for me, I would speak directly to the Almighty. I want to argue my case with God himself.

<sup>4</sup> As for you, you smear me with lies. As physicians, you are worthless quacks. Job 16:2-3 (NLT)

I have heard all this before.

What miserable comforters you are!

Won't you ever stop blowing hot air?
What makes you keep on talking?

Job 42:1-3 (NLT)

<sup>1</sup> Then Job replied to the LORD: <sup>2</sup> | know that YOU can do anything, and no one can stop you. <sup>3</sup> You asked, 'Who is this that questions **MY wisdom** with such ignorance?' It is I - and I was talking about things I knew nothing about, things far too wonderful for me.

Job 42:4-6 (NLT)

<sup>4</sup> You said, 'Listen and I will speak! I have some questions for you, and you must answer them.' 5 I had only heard about you before, but now I have seen you with my own eyes. 6 I take back everything I said, and I sit in dust and ashes to show my repentance."
