STANDING ON SOLID GROUND ~ Psalm 40:1-5

[1] I waited patiently for the LORD; he turned to me and heard my cry. [2] He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; he set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. [3] He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear and put their trust in the LORD.
[4] Blessed is the man who makes the LORD his trust, who does not look to the proud, to those who turn aside to false gods. [5] Many, O LORD my God, are the wonders you have done. The things you planned for us no one can recount to you; were I to speak and tell of them, they would be too many to declare.

APPLICATION

Ephesians 2:8-10 <u>God saved you</u> by his special favor when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; <u>it is a gift from God</u>. [9] Salvation is <u>not a reward for the good things we have done</u>, so none of us can boast about it. [10] For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, SO THAT <u>we can do the good things</u> he planned for us long ago. (NLT)

OBEDIENCE IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN RITUAL ~ Psalm 40:6-10

[6] Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but my ears you have pierced burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not require. [7] Then I said, "Here I am, I have come-- it is written about me in the scroll. [8] I desire to do your will, O my God; your law is within my heart."

Deuteronomy 17:18-19 When he takes the throne of his kingdom, he is to <u>write for himself</u> on a scroll a copy of this law, taken from that of the priests... [19] It is to be with him, and he is to read it all the days of his life so that he may <u>learn to revere the LORD</u> his God and <u>follow carefully all the words of this law</u> and these decrees...

[9] I <u>proclaim</u> righteousness <u>in the great assembly</u>; I do not seal my lips, as you know, O LORD. [10] I do not hide your righteousness in my heart; I speak of your faithfulness and salvation. I do not conceal your love and your truth from the great assembly.
