## Living with INTEGRITY at HOME ~ Psalm 101:1-4

<sup>1</sup> I will sing of your love and justice; to you, O LORD, I will sing praise. <sup>2</sup> I will be careful to lead a blameless life - when will you come to me? I will walk in my house with blameless heart.

<sup>3</sup> I will set before my eyes no vile thing. The deeds of faithless men I hate; they will not cling to me. <sup>4</sup> Men of perverse heart shall be far from me; I will have nothing to do with evil.

# IMPLICATIONS

# →One of the HARDEST places to Live with INTEGRITY is at HOME

<sup>2</sup>...I will lead a life of **INTEGRITY** in my **OWN home**. (NLT)

**INTEGRITY** is being honest, having strong moral and ethical principles

**INTEGRITY** is the state of being WHOLE and Undivided

**Proverbs 11:3** (HCS) The INTEGRITY of the upright **guides them**, but the PERVERSITY of the treacherous destroys them.

## Liars and Cheats need NOT Apply ~ Psalm 101:5-8

<sup>5</sup> Whoever slanders his neighbor in secret, him will I put to silence; whoever has haughty eyes and a proud heart, him will I not endure. <sup>6</sup> My eyes will be on the faithful in the land, that they may dwell with me; he whose walk is blameless will minister to me.

<sup>7</sup> No one who practices deceit will dwell in my house; no one who speaks falsely will stand in my presence. <sup>8</sup> Every morning I will put to silence all the wicked in the land; I will cut off every evildoer from the city of the LORD.

## IMPLICATION

## →People we SPEND Time With WILL have an IMPACT our Lives

<sup>4</sup> I will reject perverse ideas and STAY AWAY from every evil. (NLT)

<sup>6</sup> I will search for **FAITHFUL** people to be my **companions**. Only those who are ABOVE REPROACH will be allowed to serve me. (NLT)

<sup>7</sup> I will NOT allow deceivers to SERVE in my house, and liars will not stay in my presence. (NLT)

**1 Corinthians 15:33** (NIV) Do not be <u>misled</u>: Bad company CORRUPTS good character.

# → We CAN Live Godly LIVES by Carefully Choosing our FOCUS

**Colossians 3:1-3** (NLT) Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God's right hand. <sup>2</sup> Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. <sup>3</sup> For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God.

## **APPLICATION**

### WARNINGS from David...

Don't LOOK at what is VILE and VULGAR vs. 3

**Philippians 4:8** (NIV) Finally, brothers, whatever is TRUE, whatever is NOBLE, whatever is RIGHT, whatever is PURE, whatever is LOVELY, whatever is ADMIRABLE - if anything is EXCELLENT or PRAISEWORTHY - THINK ABOUT such things.

**1 Corinthians 10:23** (JBP) I may do anything, but everything is not USEFUL. Yes, I may do anything but everything is not CONSTRUCTIVE.

> Be CAREFUL how we BUILD Friendships with godless people vs. 4-5

**Psalm 1:1** (NIV) Blessed is the man who does not WALK in the COUNSEL of the WICKED or STAND in the WAY of SINNERS or SIT in the SEAT of MOCKERS.

> be Careful about LISTENING to or PARTICIPATING in Harmful Speech vs. 5

**Ephesians 4:29** (NIV) Do not let ANY unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but ONLY what is helpful for BUILDING others UP according to their needs, that it may BENEFIT those who listen.

**Ephesians 4:29** (NLT) Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

John 3:17 (NIV) For God did NOT SEND his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.

#### Take Away ??

1 Corinthians 10:12 (NIV) So, IF you think you are standing FIRM, be careful that you don't fall.

**1 Corinthians 10:12** (MSG) Don't be so naive and self-confident. You're not exempt. You could fall flat on your face as easily as anyone else.

#### We are VULNERABLE When we are...

Hungry- taking care of physical needs

Angry- annoyed irritated

Lonely- alone feeling isolated

Tired- spent physically nothing left to give

Stressed- expending a lot energy or emotion
