Ephesians 4:29 (NLT) Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an ENCOURAGEMENT to those who hear them. John 3:17 (NIV) For God did NOT SEND His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. 1 Corinthians 10:12 (NIV) So, IF you think you are standing FIRM, be careful that you don't fall.

1 Corinthians 10:12 (MSG) Don't be so naive and self-confident. You're not exempt. You could fall flat on your face as easily as anyone else.
