# → GRIEF and MOURNING are a proper response to Suffering, Pain, and Injustice

### → For such a TIME as this — that IS the Unseen HAND working

#### Jeremiah 31:35-36 (NIV)

This is what the LORD says, He who appoints the sun to shine by day, who decrees the moon and stars to shine by night, who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar - the LORD Almighty is His NAME:

Only IF these decrees vanish from
 MY sight, declares the LORD, will the
 descendants of Israel ever CEASE
 to be a nation before ME.

### Fasting was ALWAYS a spiritual act for the Jews.

It served as a demonstration of deep distress and mourning over sin, OR an expression of utter dependence on God for deliverance from an enemy.

Fasting was a facet of prayer, an urgent plea to God for mercy. HOTC

### → FAITH and TRUST lead to ACTION

<sup>16</sup> Go, gather together ALL the Jews who are in Susa, and **FAST for m**e.

...When this is done, I will GO to the king, even though it is against the law. And if I perish, I perish.

### Faith INVITES God into the midst of SUFFERING.

With the halting breath of prayer

FAITH must speak,

and its very utterance attests

God's presence.

#### Daniel 3:17-18 (NIV)

If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to SAVE us from it, and He will rescue us from your hand, O king. <sup>18</sup> But even if He does not, we want you to know, O king, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up.

Jeremiah 29:5, 7 (NIV)

#### Hebrews 12:10-11 (NIV)

<sup>11</sup> No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been TRAINED by IT.

### <sup>12</sup> THEN you will call upon ME and come and pray to ME,
