Romans 6:1-2 (JBP)

Now what is our response to be? Shall we sin to our heart's content and see how far we can exploit the grace of God? ² What a ghastly thought. We, who have died to sin how could we live in sin a moment longer?

Romans 6:3-4 (JBP)

Have you forgotten that all of us who were baptized into Jesus Christ were, by that very action, sharing in His death? 4 We were dead and buried with Him in baptism, so that just as He was raised from the dead by that splendid Revelation of the Father's power so we too might rise to new life.

Romans 6:5-6 (JBP)

If we have, as it were, shared His death, let us rise and live our new lives with Him.

⁶ Let us never forget that our old selves died with Him on the cross that the tyranny of sin over us might be broken - for a dead man can safely be said to be immune to the power of sin.

For in the gospel a righteousness **from God** is revealed, a righteousness that is

by FAITH from FIRST to LAST,

JUSTIFICATION: Freedom from sin's PENALTY

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV)

...if anyone is IN Christ,

he IS a NEW creation; the old has GONE, the NEW has come.

SANCTIFICATION: Freedom from sin's POWER

Philippians 2:12-13 (NLT)
...Work hard to show the results of your salvation, obeying God with deep REVERENCE and FEAR.

13 For God is WORKING in you, giving you the DESIRE and the POWER to DO what pleases Him.

Romans 5:20 (NIV)
...But where sin increased,
grace increased ALL the more...

1 Corinthians 12:13 (NIV)

For we WERE all BAPTIZED

by one Spirit into one body
whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free...

By placing our FAITH in Jesus
we have been spiritually immersed
INTO the person of Christ
which UNITES
and identifies us with Him.

Water Baptism pictures a person being BURIED with Christ

(submersion under water)


and being RAISED to NEW life with Christ (emergence from water).

This symbolizes the person's union with, and incorporation INTO, Christ by the baptism of the Holy Spirit. ESV

→ Baptism is an OUTWARD physical symbol of an INWARD Spiritual Reality

Matthew 28:19 (NIV)
...go and make disciples of ALL nations,
BAPTIZING them in the name of
the Father and of the Son and of the
Holy Spirit...

John 5:24 (HCS)
...Anyone who hears My WORD and
BELIEVES Him who sent Me
HAS eternal life and will
not come under judgment
but has passed from
DEATH to LIFE.



→ Our Justification DEMANDS a Heart felt Desire to GROW

- ¹ What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase?
 - ² By no means. We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer?

The point of the gospel was **NOT** to find an **EXCUSE** to continue in sin, but to give **FREEDOM** from sin.

Galatians 2:20 (NIV)

I have been crucified with Christ and
I no longer live,

but Christ lives in me.

The life I live in the body,

I live BY FAITH in the Son of God, who loved me and gave

Himself for me.

Paul emphasizes that we don't have to live **UNDER sin's power.** God does not take us out of the world or make us robots - we will still **FEEL** like **sinning**, and **sometimes** we will sin. The difference is that before we were saved we were SLAVES to our sinful nature, but NOW we can CHOOSE to LIVE for Christ. LABN

Galatians 2:20 (NIV)

...I have been crucified with Christ and

I no longer live, but Christ lives IN me.

The life I live in the body,

I live BY FAITH in the Son of God,

who **loved** me and **GAVE Himself** for me.

→ We have a **NEW** Relationship to SIN

- ² ...We **DIED to sin**; how can we **LIVE** in it any longer?
- 6 ...we should no longer be SLAVES to sin ⁷ because anyone who has DIED has been FREED from sin.

Colossians 1:13-14 (NIV)

For He has RESCUED us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves,


14 in whom we have REDEMPTION, the forgiveness of sins.

Colossians 3:2-3 (NIV)

Set your minds on things above,
not on earthly things.

³ For you DIED, and your life is
now HIDDEN with Christ IN God.

There are historical records of slaves who were **set free** but continued to **live AS IF they were slaves**. Either they could **not believe** they were **FREE**, or they were **so conditioned** to slavery that they could not imagine freedom. LABC



We know that our old sinful selves
were crucified with Christ
so that sin might lose its power
in our lives.

We are no longer SLAVES to sin.
