When her people fell into an enemy's grip, none of her allies came to her rescue. Her enemies gloated over her; they sneered at her downfall.

## **Lamentations 1:8 (NET)**

Jerusalem committed terrible sin; therefore she became an object of scorn. All who admired her have despised her because they have seen her nakedness. She groans aloud and turns away in shame.

## **Lamentations 1:18 (NET)**

The LORD is right to judge me! Yes, I rebelled against his commands. Please listen, all you nations, and look at my suffering! My young women and men have gone into exile.

**Deuteronomy 28:1-14**

Describes the **BLESSINGS** God promised **IF** the worshiped **ONLY** Him

**Deuteronomy 28:15-65**

Describes the **CURSES** God promised **IF** they worshipped **OTHER** gods

Deuteronomy 28:15 (NLT)

But if you refuse to listen to the **LORD**  
your God and **DO NOT OBEY** all the  
commands and decrees I am giving  
you today, **ALL these CURSES** will  
**come and overwhelm you:**

Deuteronomy 28:16-19 (NLT)

Your towns and your fields **WILL be cursed.**

<sup>17</sup> Your fruit baskets and breadboards **WILL be cursed.** <sup>18</sup> Your children and your crops **WILL be cursed.** The offspring of your herds and flocks **WILL be cursed.**

<sup>19</sup> Wherever you **GO** and whatever you **DO**,  
**you WILL be CURSED.**



Deuteronomy 28:20 (NLT)

The LORD Himself WILL send on  
you **CURSES, CONFUSION, and**  
**FRUSTRATION** in everything you do,  
until at last you are **completely**  
**DESTROYED** for **doing evil** and  
**abandoning ME.**

# **VIDEO Lament 1.2**

There were **THREE**  
different **Deportations** between  
607-587 BC

Jeremiah 6:10 (NLT)

To whom can I give warning?

Who will listen when I speak?

**Their ears are closed**, and they  
**cannot hear.**

**They SCORN the word of the LORD.**

They don't want to listen at all.

Jeremiah 6:16-17 (NLT)

This is what the **LORD** says: “Stop at the crossroads and look around.

**Ask for the old, godly way, and walk in it.**

Travel its path, and you will find **REST**

for your **SOULS**. But you reply,

**‘No, that’s not the road we want!’**

Jeremiah 6:16-17 (NLT)

<sup>17</sup> I posted **WATCHMEN** over you who said,  
‘Listen for the sound of the alarm.’

But you replied,

‘**No! We won’t pay attention!**’

**→ God Withdrew His COMFORT  
and Protection from Judah**

<sup>16</sup> For all these things I weep;  
tears flow down my cheeks.

**No one is here to COMFORT me...**

Jeremiah's sorrow expresses the sorrow  
of the nation. **God is the comforter,**  
but because of the people's sins,  
**He had to turned away from them**  
**and become their JUDGE.** LABS



Hebrews 10:31 (NIV)

It is a **DREADFUL** thing  
to fall into the hands of the  
**LIVING God.**

They were standing before  
God as their **JUDGE**

John 3:17 (NIV)

<sup>17</sup> For **God did not send his Son** into the world **to condemn the world**, but to **SAVE** the world **through Him**.

John 3:18 (NIV)

<sup>18</sup> Whoever **BELIEVES in Him**  
**is not condemned**, but whoever  
does **NOT believe** stands **condemned**  
**already** because he **has not believed**  
in the name of God's one and only Son.

→ **God IS Slow to ANGER and Full of Mercy Compassion and LOVE**

2:1 ...In His day of **great anger**,  
the Lord has **shown NO mercy**  
even to his Temple.

Psalm 103:8-9 (NLT)

The **LORD** is **compassionate** and **merciful**,  
**slow to get ANGRY** and **filled** with  
**unfailing love.**

<sup>9</sup> He will not constantly **accuse** us,  
nor remain **angry** forever.

Psalm 103:8-11 (NLT)

<sup>10</sup> He does not **punish** us for all our sins;  
He does not **deal harshly** with us,  
as we deserve.

<sup>11</sup> For **HIS unfailing love toward** those who  
**fear HIM** is as great as the height  
of the heavens above the earth.

**→ You REAP what you SOW**

2:17 But it is the LORD who did just as He planned. He has fulfilled the promises of disaster He made long ago. He has destroyed Jerusalem without mercy.



Galatians 6:7 (ESV)

Do not be deceived: **God is not mocked**,  
for whatever **one sows**,  
**THAT** will he also **reap**.

You reap **WHAT** you sow,  
**NOT** something else, but **THAT**.  
An act of love makes the soul more loving.  
A humble deed deepens humility.  
The **thing REAPED** is the **very thing**  
**SOWN, MULTIPLIED** a hundred fold.

Jeremiah 29:10-14 (NIV)

This is what the LORD says:

"When **seventy years are completed**  
for Babylon, I will come to you and **fulfill**  
**MY gracious promise** to bring you  
back to this place.

<sup>11</sup> For I know the **PLANS** I have for you,"  
declares the **LORD**, "**PLANS to prosper**  
**you and not to harm you, PLANS to**  
give you **HOPE** and a **FUTURE**."

12 **Then you will call upon ME** and  
come and **pray to ME,**  
and **I WILL listen to you.**

13 You will **seek ME** and **FIND ME**  
when you **seek ME**  
with **ALL your heart.**
