# INTRODUCTION

- → Corrie ten Boom
- **2 Samuel 12:7-8, 11** (NLT) Then Nathan said to David, **You are that man!** The LORD, the God of Israel, says: I anointed you king of Israel and saved you from the power of Saul. <sup>11</sup> This is what the LORD says: Because of what you have done, I will cause your own household to rebel against you.

# Full Honest ADMISSION of GUILT ~ Psalm 51:1-6

- → For the director of music. A psalm of David. When the prophet Nathan came to him after David had committed adultery with Bathsheba.
- <sup>1</sup> Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion <u>blot out</u> my **transgressions**. <sup>2</sup> <u>Wash away</u> all my **iniquity** and <u>cleanse me</u> from my **sin**.

### Three words Describe FORGIVENESS

- BLOT OUT
- WASH AWAY
- CLEANSE me

#### **Three words Describe SIN**

- > my TRANSGRESSIONS- willful Defiance of God
- > my INIQUITY- deliberate Turning Away from God's path
- > my SIN purposely missing the target

# **IMPLICATIONS**

#### → We are either FOR or AGAINST God

<sup>4</sup>**AGAINST You**, and You alone, have I sinned; I have done what is evil in Your sight... (NLT)

#### We Show That We Are...

- > FOR- God by saying YES to Him as we OBEY
- AGAINST- God by saying NO to Him choosing DISOBEDIENCE

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. <sup>4</sup> Against You, You only, have I sinned and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are proved right when you speak and justified when You judge.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Against You, especially You, I have sinned; I have DONE what is sinful in Your sight. So You are **JUST** when You **confront** me; You are **RIGHT** when You **condemn** me. (NET)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me. <sup>6</sup> Surely You desire truth in the inner parts; You teach me wisdom in the inmost place.

**1 Samuel 15:22** (NLT) But Samuel replied, What is more pleasing to the LORD: your burnt offerings and sacrifices OR your OBEDIENCE to His voice? Listen! OBEDIENCE is better than SACRIFICE, and SUBMISSION is better than offering the fat of rams.

# Seeking FORGIVENESS and RESTORATION ~ Psalm 51:7-12

(NET) 12 ... Sustain me by giving me the DESIRE to OBEY.

# **IMPLICATIONS**

#### → The DESIRE to OBEY comes From God

- <sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and **MAKE ME willing to obey You**. (NLT)
- 12 ... Sustain me by GIVING me the DESIRE to OBEY. (NET)

### Sacrifices that PLEASE God ~ Psalm 51:13-19

<sup>13</sup> Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, and sinners will turn back to You. <sup>14</sup> Save me from bloodguilt, O God, the God who saves me, and my tongue will sing of Your righteousness. <sup>15</sup> O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare Your praise. <sup>16</sup> You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; You do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. <sup>17</sup> The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, You will not despise.

<sup>18</sup> In Your good pleasure make Zion prosper; build up the walls of Jerusalem. <sup>19</sup> Then there will be righteous sacrifices, whole burnt offerings to delight You; then bulls will be offered on Your altar.

# **TAKE AWAY ??**

**2 Samuel 12:10** (NIV) ...<u>the sword will never depart from your house</u>, because you **despised ME** and took the **wife of Uriah** the Hittite to **be your own**.

### **→**God's MERCY and GRACE

We see that God **Loves the Unlovable** and **Forgives the Unforgiveable** That is what His **Mercy** and **Grace** are ALL about

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>7</sup> <u>Cleanse</u> me with hyssop, and I will be **clean**; <u>wash</u> me, and I will be **whiter than snow**. <sup>8</sup> Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones You have crushed rejoice. <sup>9</sup> Hide Your face from my sins and <u>blot out</u> all my iniquity. <sup>10</sup> Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. <sup>11</sup> Do not cast me from Your presence or take Your Holy Spirit from me. <sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.
