

Romans 5:1-2 (NIV)

Therefore, since we have been JUSTIFIED through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.

Romans 5:6-7 (NIV)

You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly.

⁷ Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, though for a good man someone might possibly dare to die.

Romans 5:8 (NIV)

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Colossians 2:13-14 (NIV)

When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us ALL our sins, ¹⁴ having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us...

Colossians 2:14-15 (NIV)

...He took it away, nailing it to the cross.

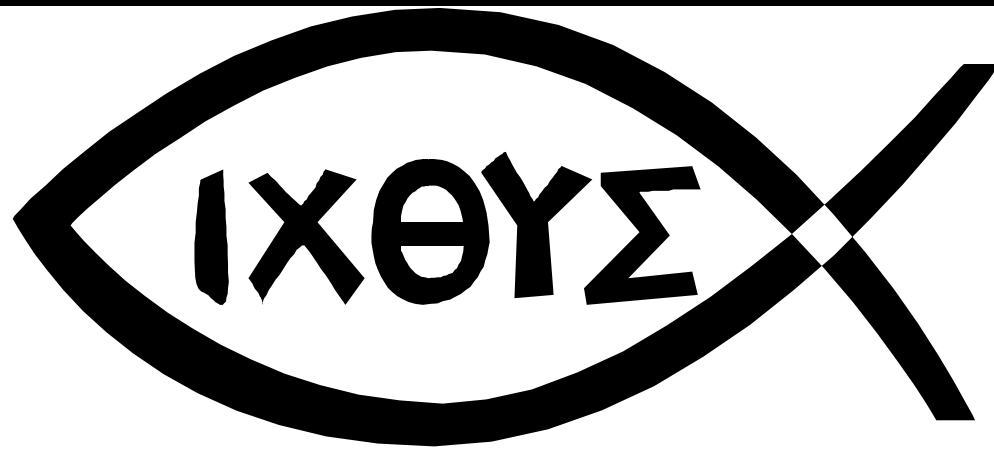
¹⁵ And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, **TRIUMPHING** over them by the cross.

1 Corinthians 1:22-23 (NIV)

Jews demand miraculous signs and
Greeks look for wisdom, ²³ but **we preach**
Christ CRUCIFIED: a stumbling block to
Jews and foolishness to Gentiles,

John 13

15 I have given you an example to follow.

DO as I have done... (NLT)

21 ...ONE of you **WILL betray Me.** (NLT)

27 **Hurry and DO** what you're going to do. (NLT)

38 ...Peter - before the rooster crows tomorrow morning, you will **DENY** three times that you **even know Me.** (NLT)

John 15

¹⁸ If the world hates you, remember that it **HATED ME first.** (NLT)

²⁰ ...A slave is **not greater than the Master...** (NLT)

³⁶ ...take this cup from Me. Yet **not what I will**, but what **You WILL**. (NIV)

Mark 15:15 (NIV)

Wanting to satisfy the crowd, Pilate released Barabbas to them. He had **Jesus flogged, and handed Him over to be crucified.**

Luke 23:33-34 (NIV)

When they came to **the place called the Skull, there they crucified Him**, along with the criminals - one on his right, the other on his left. ³⁴ Jesus said, "**Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.**" And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.

Those who **MOCKED**

Mark 15:29-32 (NIV)

Those who **PASSED BY** hurled insults at **Him**, shaking their heads and saying, "So! You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, ³⁰ come down from the cross and save yourself!"

³¹ In the same way the **CHIEF PRIESTS**
and the **TEACHERS of the LAW**
mocked Him among themselves. He
saved others, they said, but he can't save
himself. ³² Let this Christ, this King of
Israel, come down now from the cross,
THAT we may SEE and BELIEVE...

Luke 23:35-37, 39 (NIV)

The **PEOPLE** stood watching, and the **RULERS** even **sneered at Him**. They said, "He saved others; let Him save Himself if He is the Christ of God, the Chosen One." ³⁶
The **SOLDIERS** also came up and **mocked Him**. They offered Him wine vinegar

³⁷ and said, "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself." ...³⁹ **One of the CRIMINALS** who hung there **hurled insults at Him**: "Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!"

Matthew 27:45-47, 50-51 (NIV)

From the sixth hour until the ninth hour
darkness came over all the land.

⁴⁶ About the ninth hour Jesus cried out in
a loud voice, "*Eloi, Eloi, lama
sabachthani?*"- which means...

⁴⁶ ... "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" ⁴⁷ When some of those standing there heard this, they said, "He's calling Elijah."

⁵⁰ And when Jesus had **cried out** again in a **loud voice, He gave up his spirit.** ⁵¹ At that moment the **curtain of the temple was torn** in two from **TOP to BOTTOM**. The earth shook and the rocks split.

Those who **MOURNED**

Luke 23:40-41 (NIV)

But the other **CRIMINAL** rebuked him.

"Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence? ⁴¹ We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But **this man has done NOTHING wrong**

Mark 15:39-41 (NIV)

And when **the CENTURION**, who stood there in front of Jesus, heard his cry and saw how He died, he said, "**Surely this man was the Son of God!**" ⁴⁰ Some women were watching from a distance. Among them were Mary Magdalene...

...**Mary** the mother of James the younger and of Joses, and **Salome**.⁴¹ In Galilee these women had followed him and cared for his needs. **Many other women** who had come up with him to Jerusalem **were also there.**

Luke 23:48-49 (NIV)

When all the **PEOPLE** who had gathered to witness this sight saw what took place, they **beat their breasts and went away.** ⁴⁹ But **ALL those who KNEW Him**, including the women who had followed him from Galilee, stood at a distance, **watching** these things.

O, **Mighty Cross**, O Christ so pure,
LOVE held Him there, Such Shame endure;
His sacrifice on Calvary, has made
the mighty cross **a tree of life to ME.**

The journey to Jerusalem didn't begin in Jericho. It didn't begin in Galilee. It didn't begin in Nazareth. It didn't even begin in Bethlehem. **The journey to the cross** began long before. As the echo of the crunching of fruit was still sounding in the Garden of Eden,

Romans 3:25 (NIV)

God presented Him as a sacrifice of
ATONEMENT, through **FAITH** in His blood...

The Cross is the lightning rod of **GRACE**
that directs **God's WRATH** right to **Jesus**
Christ so that only the **Light of His Love**

RECONCILED- Restoring our relationship with GOD

Colossians 1:21-22 (NIV)

Once **you were alienated from God** and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. ²² But now **He has RECONCILED you by Christ's physical body through death** to present you **HOLY in His sight, without blemish** and free from accusation...

The Cross Becomes my...

- **ANCHOR** in the Storm
- **SHIELD** of Safety During the Battle
- **SWORD** that Destroys the Enemy and all my Fears
- Birth **CERTIFICATE**
