All who CALL will be SAVED ~ Romans 10:1-13

→ Scripture Reading - Romans 1:16-17, 10:9-13

INTRODUCTION

Romans 1:16-17 (NIV) I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who BELIEVES: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. ¹⁷ For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is BY FAITH from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."

Christ is the END of the LAW? ~ Romans 10:1-4

¹Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for the Israelites is that they may be saved. ²For I can testify about them that they are zealous for God, but their zeal is not based on knowledge.

Galatians 1:13-14 (NIV) For you have heard of my previous way of life in Judaism, how INTENSELY I persecuted the church of God and tried to DESTROY it. ¹⁴ I was advancing in Judaism beyond many Jews of my own age and was extremely ZEALOUS for the traditions of my fathers.

³ Since they did not know the righteousness that comes from God and sought to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. ⁴ Christ is the end of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who BELIEVES.

^{10:4} For Christ has already ACCOMPLISHED the purpose for which the law was given. (NLT)

^{1:17}...in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is BY FAITH

IMPLICATIONS

→Because of the gospel we can REST in God's GRACE

^{10:4} For Christ has already accomplished the purpose for which the law was given. As a result, ALL who BELIEVE in Him are made right with God. (NLT)

^{5:1} Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom we have gained access by faith into this GRACE in which we now STAND...

As believers we KNOW we are saved by Grace through Faith. But many times we fall back on our own hard work and efforts to feel worthy -or to silence the guilt -or to drive away the shame.

^{8:1} Therefore, there is now **NO CONDEMNATION** for those who are **IN Christ** Jesus...

Confess Jesus IS LORD ~ Romans 10:5-13

⁵ Moses describes in this way the righteousness that is BY the LAW: "The man who does these things will live by them." ⁶ But the righteousness that is BY FAITH says: "Do not say in your heart, "Who will ascend into heaven?'" (<u>that is</u>, to bring Christ down)⁷ "or 'Who will descend into the deep?'" (<u>that is</u>, to bring Christ up from the dead). ⁸ But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," <u>that IS</u>, the word of FAITH we are proclaiming:

Jesus DIED for SINS - He was BURIED and He ROSE Again 1 Cor. 15:3-4

⁹ That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and <u>believe</u> in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you <u>believe</u> and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. ¹¹ As the Scripture says, "Anyone who <u>believes</u> in Him will never be put to shame."

Not only do we believe that the man Jesus was **raised from the dead**, but we also believe that He shares the same nature with God. Jesus is fully human and fully God. Christians by definition believe and confess this truth. HCSB

¹² For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile - the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses ALL who call on Him, ¹³ for, Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

Romans 3:22-23 (NIV) This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to ALL who believe. THERE IS NO DIFFERENCE, ²³ for ALL have sinned and fall short of the glory of God...

IMPLICATIONS

→What did Paul mean when he said Jesus IS LORD?

⁹ If you confess with your mouth, "**Jesus is Lord**," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. (HCS)

Paul's statement confess **Jesus IS Lord** is misunderstood when it is made to support the claim that one cannot be saved unless he makes Jesus the Lord of his life by a personal commitment to living life under the control of the H.S. Such a commitment is very important but in this passage Paul uses the word LORD to show that Jesus IS Yahweh - God. Constable

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV) For it is BY GRACE you have been saved, through FAITH - and this not from yourselves, it is the GIFT of God⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast.

Acts 16:31 (ESV) And they said, BELIEVE in the Lord Jesus, and you WILL be saved...
