

Jeremiah 31:33 (NIV)

This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time, declares the LORD. "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people.

Jeremiah 31:34 (NIV)

No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares the LORD.

"For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more."

Jeremiah 31:35 (NIV)

This is what the LORD says, he who appoints the sun to shine by day, who decrees the moon and stars to shine by night, who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar - the LORD Almighty is his name:

Jeremiah 31:36 (NIV)

Only if these decrees vanish from my sight," declares the LORD, "will the descendants of Israel ever cease to be a nation before me."

¹ I ask, then, has God rejected His own people, the nation of Israel? Of course NOT...

¹¹ Did God's people stumble and fall beyond recovery? Of course NOT...

Romans 10:1-16

Jeremiah 31:35 (NLT)

It is the LORD who provides the sun to light the day and the moon and stars to light the night, and who stirs the sea into roaring waves. His name is the LORD of Heaven's Armies, and this is what he says:

Jeremiah 31:36 (NLT)

I AM as likely to **REJECT**
my people Israel
as **I AM** to **ABOLISH** the laws
of nature!

Israel and the Gospel

- Past **ELECTION**
- Present **REJECTION**
- Future **RESTORATION**

10:21 But to Israel He says: **All day long**
I have spread out **My hands** to a
disobedient and **defiant** people.

(HCS)

God elects BY grace NOT in spite of
but **THROUGH** the **Response of faith**.

But **GRACE** comes first,
not meritorious works from the
human side, otherwise
GRACE would no longer be **GRACE**.

In **JUDGING** them, **God removed** their ability to see and hear and to turn from sin; thus, they would experience the consequences of their rebellion.

Resisting God is like saying to Him, **Leave me alone!** ...His answer to that prayer might be to agree and make that person less sensitive, more hardened to Him. LAB

If people **REFUSE** to hear
God's Good News,
they eventually will
be **UNABLE** to understand it.

LAB

→ Let it be **GRACE ALONE**

⁶ Now if **by grace**, then it is NOT
by works; otherwise **GRACE** ceases
to be **GRACE**. HCS

2 Corinthians 8:9 (NIV)

For you know **the GRACE** of our
Lord Jesus Christ, that though
He was rich, yet for your sakes
He became poor, SO THAT you through
His poverty might become rich.

Ephesians 2:4-5 (NIV)

But because of **His great love** for us,
God, who is rich in mercy, ⁵ made us
ALIVE with Christ even when
we were DEAD in transgressions -
it is **BY**
GRACE you have been saved.

2 Timothy 1:9 (NLT)

For God saved us and called us to
live a holy life. He did this,
not because we deserved it,
but because that was His plan from
before the beginning of time - **to show us**
His GRACE through Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:10 (NLT)

And now He has made all of this
plain to us by the appearing of
Christ Jesus, our Savior.

He BROKE the power of death
and illuminated the way to life and
immortality **through the Good News.**

¹² Now if the Gentiles were enriched because the people of Israel turned down **God's offer of salvation**, think how much greater a blessing the world will share when they finally accept it.

NLT

Paul is speaking of **Israel nationally**
and of **the Gentiles** in the same way.

He is **NOT** speaking of the church
of God... MacDonald

→ **Passing from DEATH to LIFE**

¹⁵ For since their rejection meant that God offered salvation to the rest of the world, their **ACCEPTANCE will be even more wonderful**. It will be **LIFE** for those who were **DEAD!** NLT

John 5:24 (HCS)

I assure you: Anyone who

hears My word and BELIEVES

Him who sent Me **HAS eternal life**
and will not come under judgment but has
passed from DEATH to LIFE.

→ God is **NOT DONE** with Israel
because He **KEEPS** His Promises

fall beyond recovery?


