The Kindness AND Sternness of God ~ Romans 11:17-21

→ Scripture Reading Eph. 3:6, Rom 11:25, 28-31

INTRODUCTION

On the mount of crucifixion, - Fountains opened deep and wide; Through the floodgates of God's **MERCY** -Flowed a vast and **gracious** tide. **Grace** and **love**, like mighty rivers, - Poured incessant from above, And Heav'n's **peace** and perfect **justice** - **Kissed a GUILTY world in love**.

Do NOT be ARROGANT ~ Romans 11:17-24

¹⁷ If some of the branches have been broken off, and you, though a wild olive shoot, have been grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing sap from the olive root, ¹⁸ do not BOAST over those branches. If you do, consider this: You do NOT support the root, but **the ROOT supports you**. ¹⁹ You will say then, "Branches were broken off so that I could be grafted in." ²⁰ Granted. But they were **broken off because of unbelief**, and you stand by faith. Do not be arrogant, but be afraid. ²¹ For if God did not spare the natural branches, He will not spare you either. ²² Consider therefore **the kindness and sternness of God**: sternness to those who fell, but kindness to you, provided that you continue in His kindness. **Otherwise, you also will be cut off**.

ALL of God's attributes **work in harmony**; there is no conflict between His **goodness** and **love**, and His **justice** and **wrath**. Those who accept His **gracious offer of salvation** experience His GOODNESS; **those who reject** it experience His SEVERITY. MacArthur

Romans 8:38-39 (NIV) For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, ³⁹ neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is IN Christ Jesus our Lord.

²³ And **if THEY do not persist in unbelief**, they will be **grafted in**, for God is able to graft them in again. ²⁴ After all, if you were cut out of an olive tree that is wild by nature, and contrary to nature were grafted into a cultivated olive tree, how much more readily will these, the natural branches, be grafted into their own olive tree!

IMPLICATIONS

John 10:27-30 (NIV) My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. ²⁸ I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can SNATCH them out of my hand. ²⁹ My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; NO ONE can snatch them out of my Father's hand. ³⁰ I and the Father are ONE.

John 5:24 (NIV) I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and BELIEVES HIM who sent ME <u>HAS eternal life</u> and will <u>NOT be condemned</u>; he has <u>crossed over from DEATH to LIFE</u>.

Philippians 1:6 (ESV) And I am sure of this, that <u>HE who BEGAN a GOOD work in you WILL BRING IT to COMPLETION at the day of Jesus Christ.</u>

CONDITIONAL Promise - IF you BELIEVE in Jesus Christ - then you WILL BE saved Jn 5:24

UNCONDITIONAL Promise - God who STARTED this work in you WILL FINISH IT Phil 1:6

→ The Security Salvation is Based on God's PROMISES

ALL Israel will be SAVED? ~ Romans 11:25-32

²⁵ I do not want you to be ignorant of **this MYSTERY**, brothers, so that you <u>may not be conceited</u>: Israel has experienced a **hardening** in part **until the full number of the Gentiles has come in**. ²⁶ And so **ALL Israel will be saved**, <u>as it is written</u>: "The deliverer will come from Zion; He will turn godlessness away from Jacob." ²⁷ And "this is my covenant with them when I take away their sins."

Ephesians 3:6 (NIV) This MYSTERY is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise **IN Christ Jesus**.

So ALL Israel Will be SAVED ... vs. 26 ESVN

- salvation of the CHURCH Jews and Gentiles throughout history
- salvation of a REMNANT of Jews throughout history
- > salvation of the END-TIME generation of Jewish people in the future

God will **keep His promises**. The important word is **Irrevocable**, not **Irresistible**. While God will not take back what He has offered, we are certainly able to REJECT it. LAB

IMPLICATIONS

→ God hates our PRIDE and Arrogance

- ¹⁸ do not BOAST over those branches....
- ²⁰...broken off because of unbelief, and you **stand by faith**. Do not be ARROGANT...
- ²⁵ I do not want you to be ignorant of **this MYSTERY**, brothers, so that you <u>may not be conceited</u>:

TAKE AWAY??

To BELIEVE is more than intellectual agreement that Jesus died for us. It means to put our TRUST and CONFIDENCE in HIM that ONLY He can SAVE us. LASB

Ephesians 2:8-9 For it is **BY Grace** you have been **Saved**, **THROUGH Faith** - and this not from yourselves, it is the **GIFT of God** - ⁹ NOT by works, SO THAT no one can boast.

Saved BY GRACE alone -THROUGH FAITH alone

John 3:14-16 (NIV) Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, **so the Son of** Man must be LIFTED UP, ¹⁵ that everyone who BELIEVES in him may have eternal life.

¹⁶ For **God so loved the world** that He **GAVE** his one and only Son, that whoever **BELIEVES** in Him shall not perish but **HAVE eternal life**

How can we be SAVED?

- > ACCEPT the Fact you deserve to DIE
- > RECOGNIZE that Jesus DIED in Your Place
- > BELIEVE Jesus Died for you

Romans 8:31-32 (NIV) What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us? ³² He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all - how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

²⁸ As far as the GOSPEL is concerned, **they are enemies** on your account; but **as far as ELECTION** is concerned, **they are loved** on account of the patriarchs, ²⁹ for God's gifts and His call are irrevocable.

²⁹ For God's gifts and His call can **never be withdrawn**. (NLT)

³⁰ Just as you who were at one time disobedient to God have now received mercy as a result of their disobedience, ³¹ so they too have now become disobedient in order that they too may now receive mercy as a result of God's mercy to you. ³² For God has bound ALL men over to disobedience so that He may have mercy on them all.
