### HUMBLE Request for MERCY ~ Psalm 57:1-5

<sup>1</sup> Have mercy on me, O God, have mercy on me, for in You my soul takes refuge. I will take refuge in the shadow of Your wings until the disaster has passed. <sup>2</sup> I cry out to God Most High, to God, who fulfills His purpose for me. <sup>3</sup> He sends from heaven and saves me, rebuking those who hotly pursue me; *Selah* God sends His love and His faithfulness. <sup>4</sup> I am in the midst of lions; I lie among ravenous beasts - men whose teeth are spears and arrows, whose tongues are sharp swords. <sup>5</sup> Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let Your glory be over all the earth.

## **IMPLICATIONS**

### ➔ Are we Seeking REFUGE in God's SHADOW

<sup>1</sup>...I take refuge in You. I will seek **REFUGE** in the **SHADOW** of Your wings until danger passes. (HCS)

**Psalm 73:28** (NLT) But as for me, how GOOD it is to be **NEAR God!** I have **made the Sovereign** LORD my SHELTER...

**Close to You** Lord is where I want to be -You are ALL I ever hoped for ALL I ever dreamed **Close to You** Lord come and fill me with Your Fire -You know it's my desire to be **close to You** 

## →God WILL Fulfill HIS PLANS for me

<sup>2</sup> I cry out to **God MOST HIGH**, to God who **WILL fulfill His PURPOSE** for me. (NLT)

## Confident and STEADFAST Heart ~ Psalm 57:6-11

Lament is a prayer IN midst of Pain or Hardship that leads us back to Confidence and Trust IN God. Vroegop

<sup>6</sup> They spread a net for my feet - I was bowed down in distress. They dug a pit in my path - but they have fallen into it themselves. *Selah* 

**Deut. 32:35** (NIV) It is mine to avenge; I will repay. In due time their foot will slip; their day of disaster is near and their doom rushes upon them.

<sup>7</sup> My heart is steadfast, O God, my heart is steadfast; I will sing and make music. <sup>8</sup> Awake, my soul! Awake, harp and lyre! I will awaken the dawn. <sup>9</sup> I will praise You, O Lord, among the nations; I will sing of You among the peoples. <sup>10</sup> For great is Your love, reaching to the heavens; Your faithfulness reaches to the skies. <sup>11</sup> Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let your glory be over all the earth.

# IMPLICATIONS

## ➔ Focusing on God NOT his Enemies

<sup>6</sup> They prepared a net for my steps; I was despondent. They dug a pit ahead of me, but THEY FELL INTO IT. *Selah* (HCS)

## → Focusing on God in our Pain can Open the Door for PRAISE

<sup>7</sup> My heart is steadfast ...<u>I will sing</u>...

<sup>8</sup>...<u>Í will</u> awaken the dawn

<sup>9</sup> I will praise You, O Lord... ...<u>I will sing</u> of You...

<sup>10</sup> For GREAT is Your love, reaching to the heavens; Your FAITHFULNESS reaches to the skies.

Though You slay me -Yet I will praise You Though You take from me - I will bless Your name Though You ruin me - Still I will worship Sing a song to the ONE who's ALL I need

My heart and flesh may fail - The earth below give way But with my eyes, with my eyes I'll see the Lord Lifted high on that day - Behold, the Lamb that was slain And I'll know every tear was worth it all

# → May we LIVE with the GLORY of God as our FOCUS

<sup>11</sup> Be EXALTED, O God, above the highest heavens. May Your GLORY shine over all the earth. (NLT)

Better to be IN the will of God in a cave than out of His will in a king's palace. Wiersbe

**1 Corinthians 10:31** (NIV) So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, DO IT ALL for the glory of God.

We're commanded to do everything to the **glory of God**, and if EVERYTHING includes **hiding in caves**, then may the Lord be magnified. The elements of prayer, praise, and a desire for God to be magnified - **will transform any cave** into a Holy place - to the glory of God. Wiersbe

**Psalm 147:11** (NLT) ... the LORD's delight is in those who fear Him, those who put their HOPE in His unfailing love.
