INTRODUCTION

An upright, godly, or righteous man or woman will live God-Centered lives

Psalm 111:10 (NLT) FEAR of the LORD is the foundation of true wisdom. All who obey his commandments will grow in wisdom. Praise him forever!

Living a God-Centered Life ~ Psalm 112:1-4

¹ Praise the LORD. Blessed is the man who **FEARS** the LORD, who finds **great DELIGHT in His commands**.

A man or woman who is Blessed will be God-Fearing and Word-Delighting. HOTC

² His children will be mighty in the land; the generation of the upright will be blessed. ³ Wealth and riches are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever. ⁴ Even in DARKNESS light dawns for the upright, for the gracious and compassionate and righteous man.

To be God-Fearing

Proverbs 3:5-7 (NLT) Trust in the LORD with ALL your heart; <u>do not depend on your own understanding</u>. ⁶ Seek His will in ALL you do, and He will show you which path to take. ⁷ Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. INSTEAD, FEAR the LORD and turn away from evil.

To be Word-Delighting

Psalm 1:2-3 (NIV) ...DELIGHT is in the LAW of the LORD, and on His law he meditates day and night. ³ He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 (NIV) Now all has been heard; here is the conclusion of the matter: FEAR God and KEEP His commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. ¹⁴ For God will bring every deed into judgment, including every hidden thing, whether it is good or evil.

→ God Promises LIGHT in the Darkness

Being Generous Frees us From... LABN

- > the FEAR of Losing our wealth

Isaiah 43:1-3 (NIV) 1 ...this is what the LORD says - He who created you, O Jacob, He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. 2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. 3 For I am the LORD, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior...
