#### What are ORDINANCES or SACRAMENTS?

**Ordinance** or **Sacrament-** is something <u>Commanded</u> by Christ, <u>Taught</u>, and <u>Practiced</u> by the Apostles and the early church

**BAPTISM** and **COMMUNION** are the <u>only</u> ceremonial rituals <u>which qualify</u> so there can only be two Ordinances or Sacraments and **NEITHER one is required for salvation**. gotquestions.org

**SACRAMENT-** a sign/rite which <u>results in God's GRACE being received</u> almost automatically through participation in Baptism and the Lord's Supper

**ORDINANCE-** stresses OBEDIENCE in doing that which Christ explicitly commanded.

Baptism - Once for ALL

Lord's Supper - Ongoing and Regular

Preaching - makes God's Word AUDIBLE

The Ordinances - make God's Word VISIBLE

## Baptism ~ Matthew 28:18-20

# → Baptism was COMMANDED by Christ...

**Matthew 28:18-20** (NIV) Then Jesus came to them and said, All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to ME. <sup>19</sup> Therefore GO and <u>make disciples</u> of ALL nations, **BAPTIZING them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit**, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

#### BAPTISM is a...

- > step of OBEDIENCE
- public PROCLAMATION
- outward Symbol of an INWARD Reality

# →It was TAUGHT and PRACTICED by the Early Church

**Acts 16:29-31, 33** (NIV) The jailer called for lights, rushed in and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. <sup>30</sup> He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" <sup>31</sup> They replied, Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved - you and your household... <sup>33</sup> At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then **immediately he and all his family were baptized**.

In N.T. Baptism meant IDENTIFYING with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection. NBC

Baptism is NOT something we do to RECEIVE Salvation

## **APPLICATIONS**

### **EVERYONE WHO HAS...**

ADMITTED that they have sinned and need a savior

Romans 3:23 (NIV) for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 6:23 (NIV) For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- ACCEPTED by Faith the Forgiveness that Jesus freely offers
  - **Ephesians 2:8-9** (ESV) For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast.
- Seeking to SUBMIT to God in every area of their life

**Romans 6:13** (NIV)Do not offer the parts of your body to sin, as instruments of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God, as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer the parts of your body to him as instruments of righteousness.

# The Lord's Supper ~ Luke 22:19-20

#### →The Lord's Supper was Commanded by Christ...

**Luke 22:19-20** (NIV) And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." <sup>20</sup> In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you.

# →It was Taught and Practiced by the Early Church

**1 Corinthians 11:23-28** (NLT) For I <u>pass on to you</u> what I received from the Lord himself. On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus <u>took some bread</u> <sup>24</sup> and <u>gave thanks</u> to God for it. Then he <u>broke it</u> in pieces and SAID, This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to REMEMBER ME. <sup>25</sup> In the same way, he <u>took the cup of wine</u> after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people - an agreement confirmed with my blood. Do this to remember me as often as you drink it."

**Took Bread** - Gave Thanks For it - Broke it in Pieces - vs. 23-24 DO this to Remember ME

**Took the Cup of Wine -** New Covenant Established by His Blood vs. 25 DO this to Remember Me

# Every Time you Eat the Bread and Drink the Cup you... vs. 26

PROCLAIM the Lord's Death Until He COMES

**Anyone who takes** Bread or Cup in an UNWORTHY manner vs. 26 is GUILTY of sinning against body and blood of Christ

**Examine Yourself** - BEFORE taking Bread or the Cup vs. 27 so that you are NOT sinning against the Lord

### The LORDS Supper is...

- ➤ a COMMAND
- > about REMEMBERING
- > about PROCLAIMING the Lord's Death
- ONGOING

#### **TAKE AWAY ??**

**Matthew 11:28-30** (NIV) Come to ME, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you REST. <sup>29</sup> Take MY YOKE upon you and LEARN from ME, for I AM gentle and humble in heart, and you will find REST for your souls. <sup>30</sup> For MY YOKE is easy and MY burden is light.

The YOKE is a symbol of DISCIPLESHIP

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>26</sup> For <u>every time</u> you <u>eat</u> this bread and <u>drink</u> this cup, you are **announcing the Lord's death** until **He comes again**.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>27</sup> So anyone who eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord UNWORTHILY is guilty of sinning against the BODY and BLOOD of the Lord. <sup>28</sup> That is why you should examine yourself BEFORE eating the bread and drinking the cup.
