Baptism and Communion

1 Cor. 11:23-26 and Acts 2:41-42







Ordinance or Sacrament-
is something **Commanded** by Christ,
Taught, and **Practiced** by the Apostles
and the early church

BAPTISM and **COMMUNION**

are the **only** ceremonial rituals which qualify

so there can only be two Ordinances or

Sacraments and **NEITHER one is Required**

or SALVATION. gotquestions.org

SACRAMENT- is a **Sign** or a **Rite** which
results in God's GRACE being received
almost automatically through participation
in **Baptism** and the **Lord's Supper**

ORDINANCE- stresses **OBEDIENCE**
in doing that which
Christ explicitly commanded.

Baptism - Once for All

Lord's Supper - Ongoing and Regular

Preaching - makes God's Word **AUDIBLE**

The **Ordinances** - make God's Word **VISIBLE**

→ Baptism was **COMMANDED** by Christ...

Matthew 28:18-20 (NIV)

Then Jesus came to them and said, **All authority** in heaven and on earth has been given to ME. ¹⁹ Therefore **GO** and make disciples of **ALL** nations...

¹⁹...**BAPTIZING** them in the name of the **Father** and of the **Son** and of the **Holy Spirit**, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

BAPTISM is a...

- step of **OBEDIENCE**
- public **PROCLAMATION**
- outward **Symbol** of an **INWARD** Reality

→ It was **TAUGHT and PRACTICED**
by the **Early Church**

Acts 16:29-31, 33 (NIV)

The jailer called for lights, rushed in and
fell trembling before Paul and Silas.

³⁰ He then brought them out and asked,
"Sirs, what must I **do** to be **SAVED**?"

Acts 16:29-31, 33 (NIV)

31 They replied, **Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved** - you and your household...

33 At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then **immediately** he and all his family **were BAPTIZED.**

In New Testament **Baptism** meant
IDENTIFYING with Christ in His
death, burial, and resurrection. NBC

BAPTISM...

HOW should it be done?

WHO should be baptized?

Baptism is **NOT** something we
DO
to **RECEIVE** Salvation

EVERYONE Who has...

➤ **ADMITTED** that they have sinned and
need a Savior

Rom. 3:23 (NIV) for **all have sinned** and fall short
of the glory of God,

Rom. 6:23 (NIV) For the **wages of sin is death**,
but the **gift of God** is eternal life in Christ
Jesus our Lord.

EVERYONE Who has...

➤ **ACCEPTED** by **Faith** the Forgiveness
that Jesus freely off

Eph. 2:8-9 (ESV) For **by GRACE** you have
been **saved through faith**. And this is
not your own doing; it is the **gift of God**,
⁹ **NOT** a result of **works**, so that no one
may boast.

EVERYONE Who has...

- Seeking to **SUBMIT** to God in every area of their life

Rom. 6:13 (NIV) Do **NOT** offer the parts of **your body to sin**, as instruments of **wickedness**, but rather **offer yourselves to God**, as those who have been brought **from death to life**; and **offer** the parts of your body **to Him** as **instruments of righteousness**.

→ The Lord's Supper was Commanded by Christ...

Luke 22:19-20 (NIV)

And **HE** took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, This is **MY body** given for you; **DO this** in remembrance of **ME.**"

²⁰ In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, This cup is the new covenant in **MY blood**, which is poured out for you.

→ It was Taught and Practiced by the Early Church

1 Corinthians 11:23-28 (NLT)

For I pass on to you what I received from the
Lord Himself. On the night when He was
betrayed, the Lord Jesus **took some bread**
²⁴ and **gave thanks to God for it**. Then he
broke it in pieces and **SAID**, This is my body,
which is given for you.

Do this to Remember ME.

²⁵ In the same way, he **took the cup of wine** after supper, saying, This cup is the **new covenant** between **God** and His people - an agreement confirmed with my blood.

Do this to Remember ME.

as often as you drink it.”

**Took Bread - Gave Thanks For it -
Broke it in Pieces**

DO this to Remember ME

Took the **Cup of Wine** - New Covenant
Established by His Blood

DO this to **Remember ME**

**Every Time you Eat the Bread and
Drink the Cup you...**

PROCLAIM the Lord's Death
Until He **COMES**

**Anyone who takes Bread or Cup in
an UNWORTHY manner**

is **GUILTY** of sinning against **body**
and **blood** of Christ

Examine Yourself - BEFORE

taking Bread or the Cup

so that you are **NOT sinning** against
the Lord

The LORDS Supper is...

- a **COMMAND**
- about **REMEMBERING**
- about **PROCLAIMING** the Lord's Death
- **ONGOING**

Matthew 11:28-30 (NIV)

Come to ME, all you who are **weary**
and **burdened**, and **I will give you**
REST.²⁹ Take **MY YOKE** upon you and
LEARN from ME, for I AM gentle and
humble in heart, and **you will find REST**
for your souls.³⁰ For **MY YOKE** is easy
and **MY burden** is light.

The YOKE is a symbol of
DISCIPLESHIP
