## INTRODUCTION

## **IMPLICATIONS**

# Do not think of yourself more HIGHLY than you ought

Philippians 3:7-9 (NLT) I once thought these things were valuable, but now I consider them worthless because of what Christ has done.

- <sup>8</sup> Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of KNOWING Christ Jesus my Lord. For His sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ
- <sup>9</sup> and become ONE WITH HIM. I no longer count on my own righteousness through obeying the law; rather, I become righteous through FAITH in Christ. For God's way of making us right with Himself depends on FAITH.
- **1 Timothy 1:12-13** (NIV) I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength, that He considered me faithful, appointing me to His service. <sup>13</sup> Even though I WAS ONCE a <u>blasphemer</u> and a <u>persecutor</u> and <u>a violent man</u>, I was shown MERCY...

## Thinking SENSIBLY ~ Romans 12:3

<sup>3</sup> For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather THINK of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you.

**Ex. 3:11-12** (NIV) But Moses said to God, Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt? <sup>12</sup> And God said, I will be with you...
