INTRODUCTION

Mark 12:30-31 (NIV) Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these."

Loving God by being HOSPITABLE ~ Hebrews 13:1-3

- ¹ Keep on loving each other as brothers. ² Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it.
- 1 John 4:21 (HCS) And we have this command from Him: The one who loves God MUST also love his brother.
- ³ Remember those in prison as if you were their fellow prisoners, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering.
- **13:3** Remember those in prison as though you were in prison with them, and those ill-treated as though you too felt their torment. (NET)

- Praying for them GENERALLY
- Praying for them SPECIFICALLY
- Sending GIFTS
- By WRITING Letters and sending HELP

Matthew 25:37-40 (HCS) Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You something to drink? ³⁸ When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or without clothes and clothe You? ³⁹ When did we see You sick, or in prison, and visit You?' ⁴⁰ And the King will answer them, 'I assure you: Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of Mine, you did for Me.'

1 Timothy 6:6-10 (NIV) But godliness with contentment is great gain. ⁷ For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. ⁸ But if we have food and clothing, we WILL be content with that. ⁹ People who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge men into ruin and destruction. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Matthew 6:24 (NLT) No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve BOTH God and money.
