Hebrews 13:4 (CSB)

Marriage is to be honored by all and
the marriage bed kept undefiled,
because God will judge the sexually
immoral and adulterers.

Hebrews 13:5-6 (CSB)

⁵ Keep your life free from the love of money. Be satisfied with what you have, for He Himself has said, I will never leave you or abandon you. ⁶ Therefore, we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?

Loving God in PRACTICAL Ways

Hebrews 13:1-6

Mark 12:30-31 (NIV)

Love the Lord your God with ALL
your **heart** and with ALL your **soul**
and with ALL your **mind** and with
ALL your **strength.**' ³¹ The second
is this: '**Love your neighbor** as yourself.'
There is no commandment greater
than these

Hebrews 12:28 (NIV)

...since we are receiving a kingdom
that cannot be shaken, let us **be thankful**,
and so **WORSHIP God Acceptably**
with **Reverence and Awe...**

1 John 4:21 (HCS)

And we have this **command** from Him:

The one who **loves God MUST**
also love his brother.

**13:3 Remember those in prison
as though**

you were in prison with them,
and those ill-treated **as though**
you too felt their torment. (NET)

➤ Showing **HOSPITALITY**

➤ **CARING** for those who are **Suffering**
or in Prison

Hospitality- to be Welcoming in our
Attitude- to Extend Friendship- open
our Hearts and Homes

May the **Lord show mercy** to the household of Onesiphorus, because he often **refreshed me** and was **NOT ashamed of my chains.**

¹⁷ On the contrary, when he was in Rome, he **searched hard for me** until he found me.

How Can we SUPPORT Suffering Christians today?

- Praying for them **GENERALLY**
- Praying for them **SPECIFICALLY**
- Sending **GIFTS**
- By **WRITING** Letters and sending **HELP**

³⁸ **When** did we see You **a stranger** and take
You in, or without clothes and **clothe** You?

Matthew 25:39-40 (HCS)

³⁹ When did we see You **sick, or in prison,**
and visit You? ⁴⁰ And the King will answer
them, I assure you: **Whatever you did**
for one of the least of these
brothers of Mine, **you did for Me.**

1 Timothy 6:10 (NIV)

For **the LOVE of money** is a **ROOT**
of all kinds of evil. Some people,
eager for money, have **wandered**
from the FAITH and pierced themselves
with many griefs.
