³¹ What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us?

³² He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all--how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

Romans 8:35 (NIV)

35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword?

Romans 8:38 (NIV)

38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers,

Romans 8:39 (NIV)

³⁹ neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:31-39

What matters is **NOT**
WHO is against us
-BUT-
WHO is **FOR** us

8:3 ...what the **Law was POWERLESS to do**
in that it was weakened by the sinful nature,
God DID by sending His own Son in the
likeness of sinful man to
BE a SIN offering... (NIV)

2 Peter 1:3 (NIV)

His divine power has **given us everything we need** for **life and godliness** **through** our **knowledge of Him** who called us by His own glory and goodness.

→ **God is FOR US**

³¹ ...God is **FOR US**...

John 3:16 (HCS)

For **God** loved the world in this way:
He GAVE His One and Only Son,
so that everyone who **BELIEVES** in Him
will not perish but **HAVE** eternal life.

→ God is **NOT AGAINST us**

³¹...If God is **FOR US**,
who can be **AGAINST us**?

Isaiah 41:10 (NLT)

Don't be afraid, for **I AM with you.**

Don't be discouraged, **For I AM your
GOD.** I will **strengthen** you and **help** you.

I will **HOLD YOU UP** with my
victorious right hand.

We bring our **weakness** and He gives us
His strength; we bring our **sin** and **He**
forgives us by **His grace**; we bring our
emptiness and He answers with

**→ We can FACE our FEARS because
God is FOR US and He is WITH us**

Psalm 23:4 (NIV)

Even though I **walk through the valley** of the
shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for
YOU are WITH me; your rod and your staff,
they comfort me.

Romans 5:1 (NIV)

Therefore, since we have been
JUSTIFIED through FAITH, we have
PEACE with God through
our Lord Jesus Christ

John 3:17 (NIV)

For **God** did **NOT SEND** His Son into the world **to CONDEMN** the world, but to **SAVE** the world **through Him**.

33 Who dares accuse us whom **God has chosen** for His own? **No one** - for **God himself has given** us right standing with Himself. **34** Who then will condemn us? **No one** - for **Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and He is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us.** (NLT)

My sin, oh, the bliss of this glorious thought -

2 Corinthians 4:8-9 (NIV)

We are **hard pressed** on every side,
but **not** crushed; **perplexed**, but **not** in
despair; ⁹ **persecuted**, but **not** abandoned;
struck down, but **not** destroyed.

**→ NOTHING can Ever SEPARATE
us from God's LOVE**

35 Can **ANYTHING** ever **SEPARATE** us from **Christ's LOVE**? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have **trouble** or **calamity**, or are **persecuted**, or **hungry**, or **destitute**, or in **danger**, or **threatened with death**? (NLT)

**37 NO, despite ALL these things,
overwhelming victory is ours
through Christ... (NLT)**

2 Corinthians 4:8-9 (NLT)

We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair. ⁹ **We are hunted down, but never abandoned by God.** We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed.

→ I am **CONVINCED** - **NOTHING** can
Separate me From God's **LOVE**

Romans 8:38 (NLT)

And I am **CONVINCED** that **nothing** can
ever **SEPARATE** us from God's love.
