## Christ is ALL that MATTERS ~ Colossians 3:11-14

- <sup>11</sup> <u>Here</u> there is no Greek or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but **Christ is all, and is in all**.
- <sup>11</sup>...it doesn't matter if you are a Jew or a Gentile, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbaric, uncivilized, slave, or free. Christ is all that matters, and He lives in all of us. (NLT)

Romans 8:1 (NIV) ... there is now no condemnation for those who are IN Christ Jesus.

## **IMPLICATION**

11 ... Christ is ALL that matters, and He lives IN all of us. (NLT)

Romans 8:32 (NIV) He who did NOT spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all - how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?

<sup>11</sup> ... Christ is ALL that matters, and He lives IN all of us. (NLT)

# Put on LOVE ~ Colossians 3:12-14

- <sup>12</sup> Therefore, as God's **chosen people**, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
- <sup>13</sup> Bear with each other and FORGIVE whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive AS the Lord forgave you.
- <sup>14</sup> And over all these virtues **PUT ON LOVE**, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
- <sup>14</sup> Above all, **PUT ON LOVE**, which IS the **perfect bond of unity**. (CSB)

#### **IMPLICATION**

# Let Peace RULE ~ Romans 15:16-17

- <sup>15</sup> Let **the PEACE of Christ RULE** in your hearts, since as members of one body **you were called to peace**. And be thankful.
- <sup>16</sup> Let the **WORD of Christ dwell in you richly** as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.
- <sup>17</sup> And whatever you do, whether in WORD or DEED, do it **all in the NAME of the Lord Jesus**, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

## **IMPLICATIONS**

<sup>15</sup> Let the peace of Christ RULE in your hearts...

Romans 5:1 (NIV) ...since we have been justified THROUGH faith, we HAVE peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ...

<sup>8</sup> But God demonstrates **His own love for us** in this: WHILE we **were still sinners**, **Christ DIED for us**.

**Philippians 4:6-7** (NIV) Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

<sup>7</sup> And **the PEACE of God**, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
