Yes, each of us will give a personal account to God. ¹³ So let's stop condemning each other. Decide instead to live in such a way that you will not cause another believer to stumble and fall.

Romans 14:14 (NLT)

I know and am convinced on the authority of the Lord Jesus that no food, in and of itself, is wrong to eat. But if someone believes it is wrong, then for that person it is wrong.

Romans 14:17-18 (NLT)

For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of what we eat or drink, but of living a life of goodness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. ¹⁸ If you serve Christ with this attitude, you will please God, and others will approve of you, too.

Romans 14:19 (NLT)

So then, let us aim for harmony in the church and try to build each other up.

**1- Genuine Acceptance of one another
should ALWAYS be our goal
as believers**

**2- Christians can disagree over
Preferences and Practices and BOTH
be Right with God**

**3- We must Submit to the Lordship of
Christ FIRST - and stop Judging
other Believers**

⁹ And **does the master thank the servant** for doing what he was told to do? Of course not.

¹⁰ In the same way, **when you obey ME** you should say, **‘We are unworthy servants who have simply done our duty.’**”
