Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.

Hebrews 11:6 (NIV)

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

Hebrews 11:27 (HCS)

By faith he left Egypt behind, not being afraid of the king's anger, for Moses persevered as one who sees Him who is invisible.

Hebrews 11:28 (HCS)

By faith he instituted the Passover and the sprinkling of the blood, so that the destroyer of the firstborn might not touch the Israelites.

Hebrews 11:29 (HCS)

By faith they crossed the Red Sea as though they were on dry land. When the Egyptians attempted to do this, they were drowned.

- ²⁴ He **refused** to be known as the son of pharaoh's daughter
- ²⁵ He **chose** to be mistreated along with the people of God

When Moses RETURNED to Egypt...

> Jewish slaves BELIEVED he was the DELIVERER

Ex. 4:31 (NIV) ...And when they heard that the LORD was concerned about them and had seen their misery, they bowed down and worshiped.

> He CAUSED severe HARDSHIP for Israel

Ex 5:22-23 (NIV) Ever since I went to Pharaoh to speak in Your Name, he has brought **trouble upon** this people, and you have not Rescued Your people at all.

God used him to Implement the 10 PLAGUES

Ex 10:21-22 (ESV) Then the LORD said to Moses, Stretch out your hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, a darkness to be felt

²⁷ By FAITH he led the exodus from Egypt; he defied the king's anger with the strength that came from obedience to the invisible king.

Exodus 10:28 (ESV)

Then Pharaoh said to him, **Get away from me**; take care never to see my face again, for on the **day** you see **my face** you shall **die**.

Moses's faith was such that he responded to God's commands as though God were standing visibly before him. MacArthur

There in the ground His body lay, Light of the world by darkness slain; then, bursting forth in glorious day, up from the grave He rose again!

And as He stands in VICTORY, sin's curse has lost its grip on me; for I am His and He is mine, bought with the precious blood of Christ.



Moses instituted the Passover as a Lasting Ordinance to be done year after year which means that Moses never doubted in the least that the people would be delivered from Egypt.

Exodus 12:14 (NIV)

This is a day you are to **commemorate**; for the **generations to come** you shall celebrate it as a **festival** to the **LORD** - a **lasting ordinance**.

By FAITH Moses...

- ➤ Believed God and ACTED
- ➤ got the people READY to LEAVE
- ★ told everyone to apply BLOOD to Doorpost

Ephesians 1:7-8 (NIV)

In Him we have REDEMPTION through His blood, the FORGIVENESS of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's GRACE that He lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding.

In Christ alone who took on flesh, fullness of God in helpless Babe!

This gift of love and righteousness, scorned by the ones He came to save.

'Til on that cross as Jesus died, the wrath of God was satisfied.

For every sin on Him was laid; here in the death of Christ I Live.

ADMIT you are **LOST** sinner who Needs a to be Saved

Rom 6:23 (ESV) For the wages of sin is DEATH, but the FREE GIFT of God is eternal life IN Christ Jesus our Lord.

ASK pray believing Jesus Died for you

Jn. 1:12 (NIV) Yet to all who **RECEIVED Him**, to those who **BELIEVED in His name**, He gave the right to become children of God...

ACKNOWLEDGE thank God for His Gift of Salvation

Eph 2:8-9 (NIV) For it is by **grace** you have been **SAVED**, **through faith** - and this not from yourselves, it is the **GIFT of God** ⁹ NOT **by works**, so that no one can boast.

Exodus 14:13-14 (NLT)

But Moses told the people, Don't be afraid. Just stand still and watch the LORD rescue you today.

The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again.

14 The LORD Himself will fight for you. Just stay calm.

Exodus 14:15 (NLT)

Then the LORD said to Moses, Why are you crying out to me?
