Awareness of your sin should not keep you away from Communion but should drive you to participate in it.”*

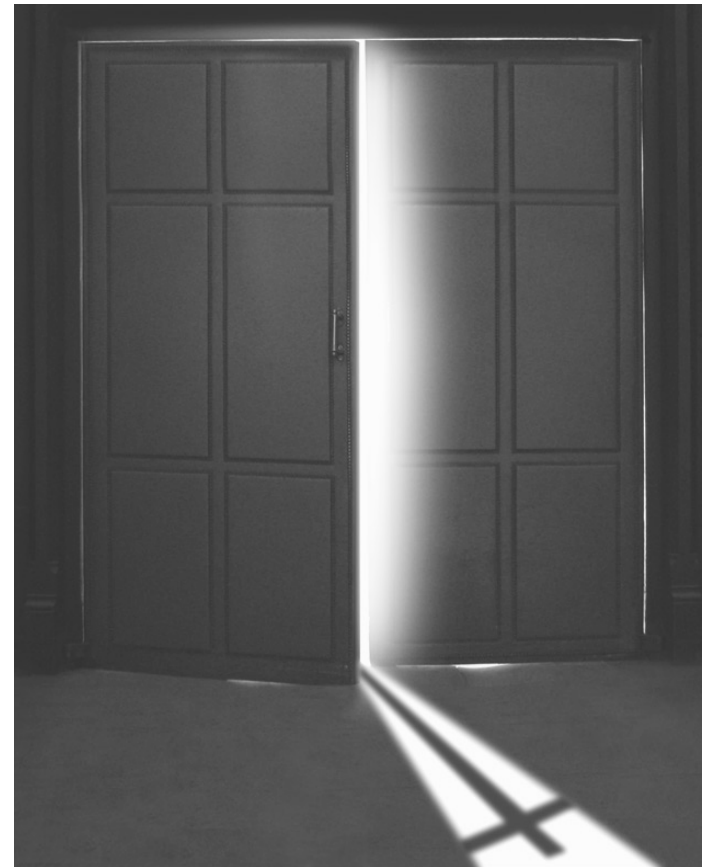
