²⁷ Just ONE thing: Live your life in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ... (HCS)

²⁷...I will know that you STAND FIRM in one spirit, CONTENDING as one man for the FAITH of the gospel ²⁸ WITHOUT being frightened in any way by those who oppose you...

Walking Worthy means we...

- Stand FIRM Refuse to be MOVED
- Stand FEARLESSLY we are Not ALONE
- Strive and Compete TOGETHER Side BY Side

Hebrews 11:16 (NIV) ...they were longing for a better country - a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ASHAMED to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them.

The fact that enemies cause **Believers** to experience the **second gift** indicates that they have **truly received the first**. Ellsworth

takes our eyes off of earthly COMFORTS
weeds out superficial believers
Strengthens the faith of those who endure
serves as an EXAMPLE for others

 Romans 5:1-5 (NIV)
¹ Therefore, since we have been JUSTIFIED through FAITH, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

² through whom we have gained access by Faith INTO this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the HOPE of the glory of God.

³ Not only so, but we also rejoice in our SUFFERINGS, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; ⁴ perseverance, character; and character, hope.

⁵ And HOPE does not disappoint us, because God has poured out HIS love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom He has given us.

²⁹ For you have been given not only the privilege of trusting in Christ but ALSO the privilege of suffering for Him. (NLT)

Observations...

 WHEN we suffer for our faith it does NOT mean that we have done something wrong
At times God uses suffering to BUILD Character

Paul never urges Christians to SEEK Suffering
Suffering is NOT a way of Paying for our sins
Remember we NEVER have to Suffer alone

2 Timothy 3:11–12 (NLT)

You know all about how I was persecuted in Antioch, Iconium, and Lystra - but the Lord Rescued me from all of it.

Yes, and everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.

HUMILITY does not mean putting ourselves down but rather lifting others up. HNTC
