#### Contentment is NOT Learned Quickly or Easily

#### <sup>11</sup>...I have **LEARNED** how to be **CONTENT** with whatever I have. (NLT)

#### Contentment is LEARNED through exposure to times of NEED and times of PLENTY. It involves a regular struggle to BELIEVE that Christ IS ENOUGH.

#### Contentment is based on total DEPENDENCE on Christ

<sup>13</sup> I can do ALL THINGS through HIM who strengthens me. (ESV)

Christian CONTENTMENT is rooted in our relationship with Christ. It flows from our UNION and COMMUNION with our Savior.

Paul is not preoccupied with his situation;
he is preoccupied with Jesus.
This is the secret. When you focus
on Jesus, you can be CONTENT.

Lamentations 3:25-26 (NLT) The LORD is good to those who DEPEND on Him, to those who search for Him. <sup>26</sup> So it is GOOD to wait quietly for salvation from the LORD.
