→ Many times our Giving will be SACRIFICIAL

¹⁸ ...I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. They are a fragrant OFFERING, an acceptable SACRIFICE, pleasing to God.

→ This is NOT a description of the Prosperity Gospel

¹⁹ And my God will meet all your NEEDS according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

God will meet your Needs BY giving you the STRENGTH to keep on going without food, to keep on going in the face a beating or death and Still HONOR God.

Hebrews 4:16 (NIV) ...approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of NEED.

Verse 19 does NOT tell us that God's people will NEVER experience or feel a NEED. Instead it tells us that God will supply the NEEDS of His people. He sometimes does this by MEETING the Need and sometimes by giving His people the strength to FACE the need head on. DACarson

- the power to ENDURE when ALL seems Lost
- the ability to be CONTENT even when Hungry

Philippians 4:11-13 (JBP) ¹¹...I have learned to be Content, whatever the circumstances may be. ¹²...I have learned the secret of facing either PLENTY or POVERTY. ¹³ I am ready for anything THROUGH the Strength of the ONE who lives within me.
