God will meet your Needs by giving you the STRENGTH to keep on going without food, to keep on going in the face a beating or death and Still HONOR God.

Hebrews 4:16 (NIV)

...approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of NEED.

Verse 19 does NOT tell us that God's people will

NEVER experience or feel a NEED. Instead it tells us
that God will supply the NEEDS of His people.

He sometimes does this by MEETING the Need and
sometimes by giving His people the strength to
