### 2 Chronicles 17:4 (NLT)

He sought his father's God and obeyed his commands instead of following the evil practices of the kingdom of Israel.

### 2 Chronicles 17:6 (NLT)

He was deeply committed to the ways of the LORD. He removed the pagan shrines and Asherah poles from Judah.

### **2 Chronicles 17:10 (NLT)**

Then the fear of the LORD fell over all the surrounding kingdoms so that none of them wanted to declare war on Jehoshaphat.

### 2 Chronicles 20:15 (NLT)

...Listen, all you people of Judah and Jerusalem! Listen, King Jehoshaphat! This is what the LORD says: Do not be afraid! Don't be discouraged by this mighty army, for the battle is not yours, but God's.
