2 Chronicles 17:3, 6 (ESV) The LORD was with Jehoshaphat, because he walked in the earlier ways of his father David. He did not seek the Baals...

⁶ His heart was courageous in the ways of the LORD. And furthermore, he took the high places and the Asherim OUT of Judah.

Did they... Bibleproject

- Worship the God of Israel ALONE?
- Purge Israel of IDOLATRY?
- Remain FAITHFUL to the Covenant?

The Role of PROPHETS was to... Bibleproject

- SPEAK on For God
- be Covenant WATCHDOGS
- Point out IDOLATRY and INJUSTICE
- Challenge Israel to REPENT and FOLLOW God
- Remind Israel they were to be the LIGHT to the Nations

The REQUEST ~ 2 Chronicles 18:1-5

¹ Jehoshaphat enjoyed great riches and high esteem, and he made an ALLIANCE with Ahab of Israel by having his son marry Ahab's daughter.

1 Kings 16:30–33 (NLT) ³⁰ But Ahab did what was EVIL in the LORD's sight... ³² First Ahab BUILT a temple and an altar for Baal in Samaria. ³³ Then he SET UP an Asherah pole. He did MORE to provoke the anger of the LORD, the God of Israel, than any of the other kings of Israel before him.

² A few years later he went to Samaria to visit Ahab, who prepared a great banquet for him and his officials. They butchered great numbers of sheep, goats, and cattle for the feast. Then Ahab enticed Jehoshaphat to join forces with him to recover Ramoth-gilead. ³ "Will you go with me to Ramoth-gilead?" King Ahab of Israel asked King Jehoshaphat of Judah. Jehoshaphat replied, Why, of course! You and I are as one, and my troops are your troops. We will certainly join you in battle ⁴ Then Jehoshaphat added, But FIRST let's find out what the LORD says... (NLT)

¹³ But Micaiah replied... I will say ONLY what my God says." (NLT)

²⁵ "Arrest him!" the king of Israel ordered... ²⁶ ...Put this man in prison, and feed him nothing but bread and water until I return safely from the battle!'

John 13:15–16 (NIV) ¹⁵ I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.

¹⁶ I tell you the truth, no servant is GREATER than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him.

Observations...

Proverbs 19:21 (ESV) Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the LORD that will stand.

3- We will Always harvest what we plant

Galatians 6:7 (NIV) Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.

Applications...

1- It is Impossible to ESCAPE the Judgment of God

Romans 8:1 (NIV) Therefore, there is now NO Condemnation for those who are IN Christ Jesus,

2- The Plans and Purposes of God will STAND

Isaiah 55:8–9 (NET) "Indeed, my plans are not like your plans, and my deeds are not like your deeds, ⁹ for just as the sky is higher than the earth, so my deeds are superior to your deeds and my plans superior to your plans.

3- We will Always harvest EXACTLY what we plant

Galatians 6:9–10 (NIV) Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest IF we do not give up. ¹⁰ Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.
