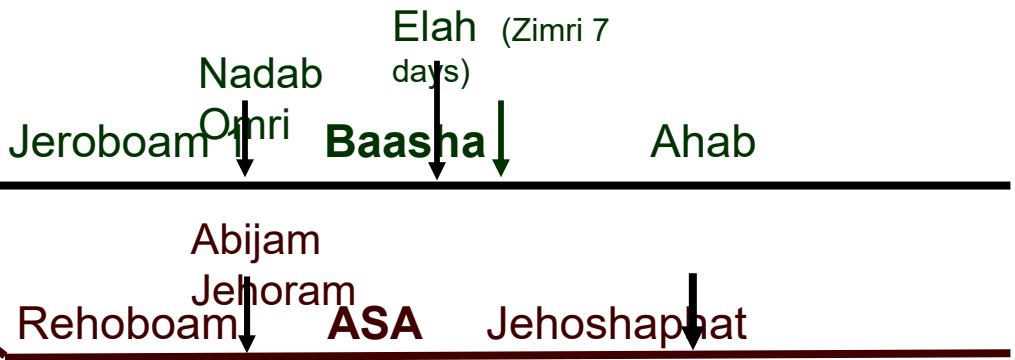

Elijah was calling Israel back to

Isaiah 45:5–7 (NIV)

**I am the LORD, and there is NO other;  
apart from ME there is no God.**

I will strengthen you, though you have not  
acknowledged me,

<sup>6</sup> SO THAT from the rising of the sun to the place of its setting **men may know** there is **NONE** besides **ME**. I am the **LORD**, and there is **NO other**.

Luke 16:13 (NIV)

No **servant can serve two masters**. Either he will **hate** the one and **love** the other, or he will be **devoted** to the one and **despise** the other.

**You cannot serve both God and Money.**
